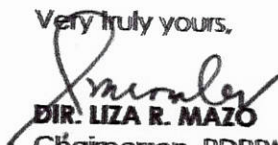

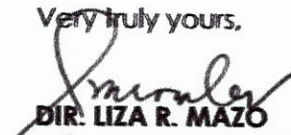

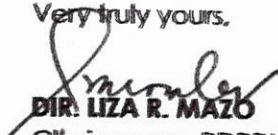

RSC RESOLUTION NO. 1 – 2019

**"A RESOLUTION ENDORSING TO THE REGIONAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND

WHEREAS, Gawad is a Filipino term for "award", while KALASAG is an acronym for KALAmidad at SAKuna Labanan, SARiling Galing ang Kaligtasan and another Filipino term for "shield" used by early Filipinos as a means of protection from attacks of enemies or harmful animals;

WHEREAS, the Gawad KALASAG was designed to encourage the participation of various stakeholders in crafting and implementing DRRM-related policies, strategies and programs to protect or shield high risk communities from the adverse impacts of natural and human-induced calamities and render them more capable of addressing their vulnerabilities and coping from disasters;

WHEREAS, the Search for Gawad KALASAG is an annual activity of the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (NDRRMC) in recognition of the outstanding performance and contributions of qualified local government units (LGUs), non-governments organizations (NGOs), private organizations, and other concerned stakeholders in the field of DRRM and Humanitarian Assistance;

WHEREAS, Gawad KALASAG as a mechanism in providing the measurement and standard of excellence in DRRM and in humanitarian assistance is guided by a set of principles, to include among others: stakeholders' participation, transparency, innovativeness, partnership, self-reliance, and the spirit of volunteerism;

WHEREAS, NDRRMC Memorandum Circular No. 03 series of 2018 dated April 8, 2018 re Revised Guidelines on the "Gawad KALASAG" Search for Excellence in DRRM and Humanitarian Assistance was amended through NDRRMC Memorandum Circular 23 series of 2019 dated March 19, 2019;

WHEREAS, RDRRMC Memorandum No. 3 s. of 2019 dated January 24, 2019 was issued to formally commence and enjoin all concerned stakeholders to participate in the various categories of award of the search;

WHEREAS, all Local DRRMCs, organizations, institutions, groups, and individuals shall be eligible as nominees to the Gawad KALASAG Search subject to the guidelines and criteria set forth by the NDRRMC and shall undergo desktop evaluation and field validation as part of the selection process;

WHEREAS, the Regional Selection Committee (RSC) is tasked on the following: to coordinate activities for the implementation of the national assessment and award system; encourage maximum participation of organizations/institutions/individuals in all categories; evaluate regional entries in accordance with the NSC Guidelines and Criteria; ensure determination of proper category of every entry; and conduct desk evaluation and field validation of regional entries and recommend the top one (1) winner of each category to the Chairman, NSC.

WHEREAS, the Regional Search Committee (RSC) for Gawad KALASAG is composed of the regional offices of OCD as Chair, DILG, DOST, DSWD and NEDA as Co-Chairs with members including BFP, CHED, DA, DENR, DEPED, DOH, DPWH, DTI, DOST PAGASA, PHILIPPINE RED CROSS AND SIKAP, INC. These RSC Members undertook the selection process of determining this year's Regional Winners as official nominees to the 21st National Gawad KALASAG Search;

WHEREAS, evaluation of entries were done in three levels such as desktop evaluation on April 29-30, 2019 which was a preliminary screening to determine the compliance of documentary requirements as provided in the Assessment Checklist, the conduct of simultaneous field validation on May 14-22, 2019 and the final assessment of entries on May 23-24, 2019;

WHEREAS, after careful review and deliberation of the entries, the RSC endorsed to the RDRRMC the results of the Final Assessment declaring the First, Second and Third Place Winners as well as the Citations for Non-Winners for this year's Regional Gawad KALASAG Search with finality as attested by the respective validators of the various categories of award hereto attached under separate sheet which forms part of this resolution;

The two-day desktop evaluation of provincial entries for the 2019 Regional Gawad KALASAG Search started at 9:00 in the morning with Ms. April Rose Anne Y. Sanchez presiding. It was commenced with a prayer through a multimedia presentation while the acknowledgement of attendees was done by Ms. Sanchez who also presented the agenda of the activity which were unanimously agreed. She then gave brief guidance of the activity.

Ms. Sanchez mentioned that table-top or desktop evaluation of entries was conducted on April 29-30, 2019 as preliminary screening to determine the compliance of documentary requirements as provided in the Assessment Checklist (30% submission/compliance to documentary requirements). Except for the provincial category, only the top 3 entries of

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the rest of the categories based on the desktop evaluation were subjected to actual field validation. Hence, all participating institutions were advised to use the Assessment Checklist as guide to ensure completeness of the documents and be mindful of the deadline set by the RSC for the submission of entries. The RSC only considered entries endorsed by the Provincial Selection Committees (PSCs) especially for LGU-related categories (province, city, municipality and barangay).

Further, Ms. Sanchez narrated that the field validation which is 70% of the total rating was simultaneously conducted on May 14-22, 2019 for the various categories. It covered all entries in the provincial category and the top 3 entries in the other categories wherein the DRRM innovations and best practices at the local level, actual simulation exercise/drills and interviews with communities were presented and conducted. She added that the ranking of entries follows using the results of the desktop evaluation and field validation of entries.

After the briefing, the final assessment process commenced. Each team evaluated its respective category. The thorough deliberations ended at 4:00 in the afternoon on the 2nd day and the following are the final results based on the desktop evaluation and field/actual validations as part of the selection process:

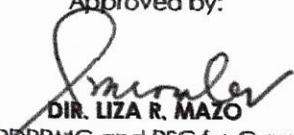

3. Proceedings

The two-day desktop evaluation of provincial entries for the 2019 Regional Gawad KALASAG Search started at 9:00 in the morning with Ms. April Rose Anne Y. Sanchez presiding. It was commenced with a prayer through a multimedia presentation while the acknowledgement of attendees was done by Ms. Sanchez who also presented the agenda of the activity which were unanimously agreed. She then gave brief guidance of the activity.

Ms. Sanchez mentioned that the two-day activity served as a preliminary screening to determine the compliance of documentary requirements as provided in the Assessment Checklist (30% submission/compliance to documentary requirements). Except for the

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provincial category, only the top 3 entries of the rest of the categories based on the desktop evaluation will be subjected to actual field validation. Hence, all participating institutions were advised to use the Assessment Checklist as guide to ensure completeness of the documents and be mindful of the deadline set by the RSC for the submission of entries. The RSC only considered entries endorsed by the Provincial Selection Committees (PSCs) especially for LGU-related categories (province, city, municipality and barangay).
