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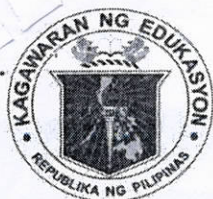
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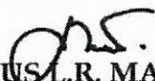

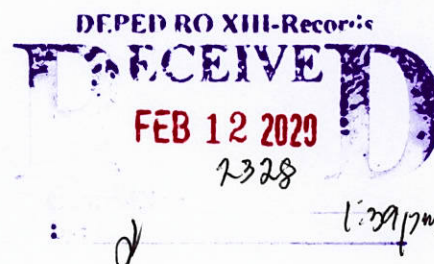

The Department of Education (DepEd) continues to strengthen evidence-based decision-making, planning, and program and policy development through the conduct of research and dissemination and utilization of relevant research findings. The Department has established mechanisms to sustain the gains in ensuring that education programs, policies, and practice are informed by results of research studies across governance levels in a variety of education topics.

themes and topics are focused on the perspectives on addressing the challenges on quality of basic education in support of the Department's recent campaign, *Sulong EduKalidad*

Research O'clock, a dissemination forum launched last 2018, seeks to promote the use of research results and evidence in decision-making, program designing and implementation, plan formulation, and adjustment. Specifically, the activity aims to:

1. Provide a venue for DepEd offices to learn from research findings from different sectors and organizations; and

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2. Promote open discussions and continuous learning experience for education leaders, researchers, policy makers, and educators in the basic education sector.

For this year's research forum, selected research studies from the Basic Education Research Fund (BERF) facility will be presented together with other studies conducted by partner organizations. Themes and topics of research studies are focused on the perspectives on addressing the challenges on quality of education in support to the Department's recent campaign, *Sulong EduKalidad*. All DepEd personnel, research practitioners, research enthusiasts, policy makers, program managers, and individuals with interest in specific education issue or topic from different sectors are invited to attend the forum.

This February, the theme for research forum is "*Addressing the Challenges on the Quality of Basic Education: Focus on Reading Literacy*". The forum aims to capture evidences on reading literacy in both elementary and secondary level through the action research studies conducted by the teachers. Action research studies identified the challenges and difficulties on reading performance which motivated the teachers to test innovative teaching-and-learning strategies and intervention programs on reading.

In line with this, we would like to invite Ms. Adelyn P. Espina, Mr. Christopher D. Balatero, Ms. Maria Fe Flor P. Jacquez of Albor Central Elementary School, Schools Division Office of Dinagat Island, Caraga Region to present their action research titled, "*Using Localized Stories to Improve Reading Literacy Skills of Grade One Learners*" on March 2, 2020 at Bulwagan ng Karunungan, DepEd Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City.

Once the BERF researchers confirmed their participation in the forum, we will send the guidelines for presentation and other logistical details to their email addresses. We wish to have their confirmation on or before February 17; 12:00 nn.
