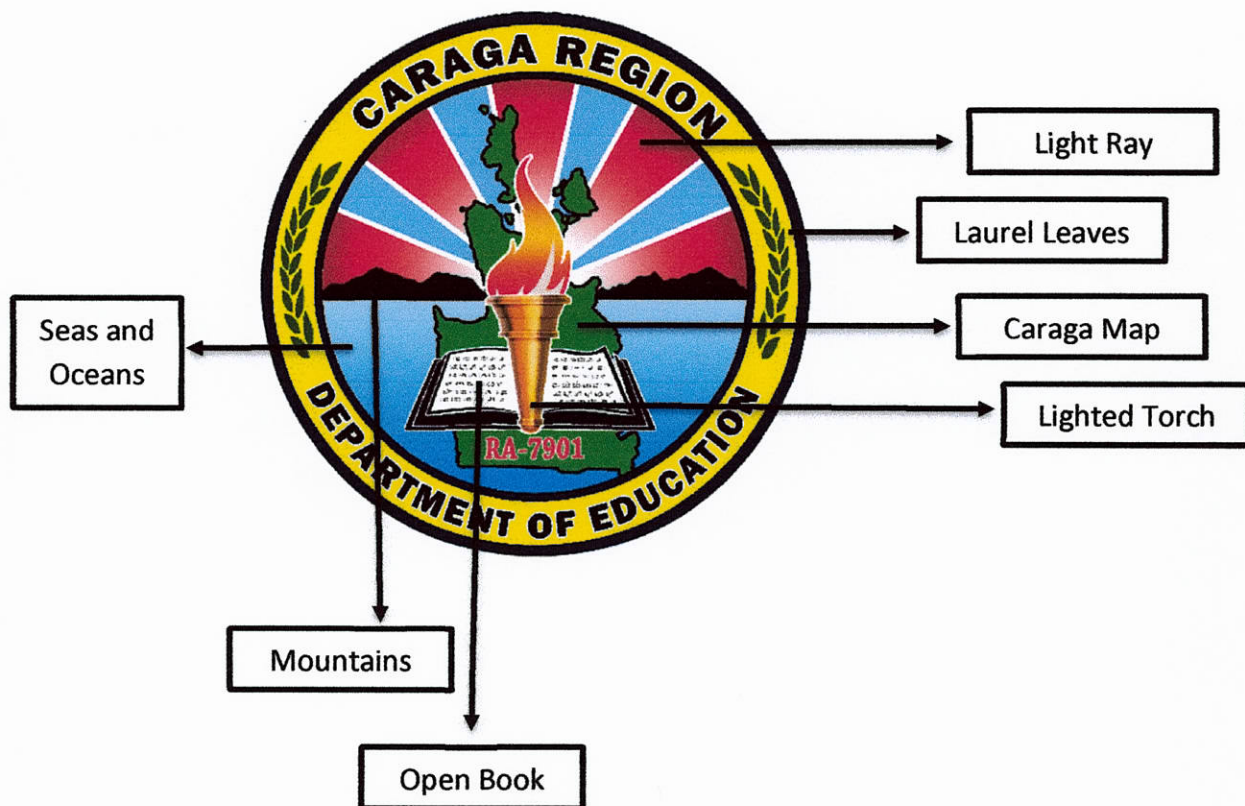

ADOPTION AND INTRODUCTION OF DEPED
CARAGA'S NEW SEAL AND STATIONERY

1. In compliance to DepEd Order No. 031, s. 2019 on the Department of Education Service Marks and Visual Identities, this Regional Office is adopting and introducing its new seal and stationery effective immediately.
2. The new official DepEd Caraga Seal is interpreted and appears as follows:



Laurel Leaves – In education, laurel leaves symbolize victory against ignorance, hardships, and struggles, the emblem of one's determination to succeed.

Caraga Map – The map is the geographic representation of the Caraga Region marked with RA 7901, the law that created it which also became the basis of DepEd Order No. 38, s. 1995 that created DepEd Caraga.

Mountains, Seas, and Oceans – These geographical features closely portray Caraga's identity as a rich source of natural resources and as one of the country's major tourist attractions. These also symbolize the height and the depth of DepEd Caraga's efforts toward achieving quality education for all Caraganons.

Lighted Torch - The lighted torch symbolizes the capacity of education leaders, teachers, stakeholders, partners, and learners who, in one way or another, have become guiding lights to each other.

Red Light Rays –The five light rays represent the five provinces of the Region namely Agusan del Norte, Agusan del Sur, Surigao del Norte, Surigao del Sur, and Dinagat Islands. These provinces work together as a unified beacons of hope, armed with the dynamism in dispelling the darkness of ignorance through the effective delivery of quality education by the workforce united in service.

Open Book –The book signifies the source of learning. It also speaks of DepEd Caraga's full commitment to deliver basic education which is free and accessible to all.
