1. Pursuant to DepEd Memo No. 030, s. 2018, the 8th ASEAN QUIZ National Level Competition shall be conducted by the People's Television Network (PTN) on April 3-6, 2018 at the PTV Broadcast Center, Visayas Avenue, Quezon City.
2. In preparation for the Regional Level Competition, the division offices are encouraged to conduct the Division Level Competition to determine the official one (1) contestant who shall represent the division and compete in the Regional level competition on March 21, 2018 at RELC 2, Bulwagan ng Karunungan, Teacher Development Center, Butuan City.
3. The student-participants of the ASEAN QUIZ competition shall have the following qualifications:
 - a. Must be in Grade 9 to 10, between 15 to 17 years old and must not be 18 years old by the time of the Regional Competition in Indonesia;
 - b. Must come from either a public or a private school;
 - c. Must be proficient in the English language, both oral and written;
 - d. Must have a grade of 85 and above in Social Studies during the first quarter of School Year 2017-2018;
 - e. Must be physically fit;
 - f. Must have good interpersonal skills/good team player;
 - g. Must be willing (with parental consent) to travel to Quezon City for the National Level Competition as well as for the Regional Competition in Bali, Indonesia in 2018; and
 - h. Must meet other criteria that may be deemed necessary by the 8th ASEAN Quiz Organizing Committee Philippines.

4. The aforementioned qualifications shall also be observed in the division and regional level competition.

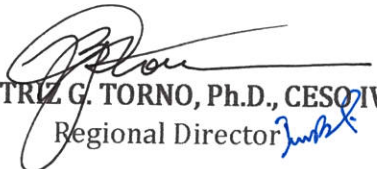

2018 CULTURAL CENTER OF THE PHILIPPINES SUMMER ARTS ACADEMY

1. The Cultural Center of the Philippines (CCP), through its Arts Education Department, will conduct a series of workshops under the **2018 CCP Summer Arts Academy** for teachers of Senior High School (SHS) Arts and Design Track, and the Special Program in the Arts (SPA) from April 23 to 27, 2018 at the Silliman University, Dumaguete City and from April 30 to May 4, 2018 at the Cultural Center of the Philippines, CCP Complex, Roxas Boulevard, Pasay City and the University of the Philippines, Diliman, Quezon City.
2. The 2018 CCP Summer Arts Academy is especially designed to provide teachers (non-beginners) with professional and specialized training on their respective art forms, to build their capacities and advance their creative development by focusing on production and performance techniques/processes, arts knowledge and skills, and pedagogical approaches. Only 25 teachers will be accepted per module.
3. Preference will be given to teacher-applicants who are actively engaged in creative and artistic/management productions/activities or those who are actively engaged in mentoring/coaching students in the arts for recent competitions such as National Music Competitions for Young Artists (NAMCYA), National Festival of Talents (NFOT) and other national and international competitions/exhibitions in the different fields of art.
4. The 2018 CCP Arts Academy shall consist of workshops and training modules to be facilitated by teachers-artists and practitioners from the CCP resident companies and partners.

5. The workshop modules include the following:

April 23–28, 2018 Silliman University, Dumaguete City	Folkdance Staging by <i>Bayanihan</i> National Folkdance Company	This aims to teach the theatricalization of folkdance as art through staging.
	Ballet/Contemporary Technique by Ballet Philippines (BP)	This focuses on the processes and tools in ballet and contemporary dance technique.
	Musical Arranging for Rondalla by Nelson Espejo	This aims to enable the teachers to learn the fundamentals of musical arranging for rondalla.
	Advanced Acting by <i>Tanghalang Pilipino</i>	This aims to arm teachers with advanced acting methods and techniques.
	Technical Theater by Barbara Tantiongco, ACC Grantee	This is a practical technical theater technique on lighting, set sound, and house management.
	Printmaking Techniques by Association of <i>Pinoy</i> Printmakers	This aims to train teachers on the wonders and different applications of printmaking.
	Cinematography by Neil Daza	This aims to train teachers on the art of writing scripts.
	Scriptwriting by Glenn Mas ACC Grantee	This aims to train teachers on the art of writing scripts.
April 30–May 4, 2018 Cultural Center of the Philippines	Batang Sining: Creative Expression by Dr. Luis Gatmaitan	This is a trainors training for elementary teachers to develop children's skills in creative expression and discover their wealth of creativitiy.
	Design for Folk Dance Performance by Ramon Obusan Folkloric Group	A specialized workshop in costume, accessories design and performance.
April 30–May 4, 2018 UP Theater Complex, University of the Philippines, Diliman, Quezon City	Production Design To be announced (TBA)	Teachers will be immersed or by various set and production design techniques for performing arts.
	Directing Theater by Josefina Estrella, ACC Grantee	This is a specialized course in directing for theater.
	Arts Education Pedagogy TBA	This is a workshop on the pedagogies of teaching the arts.

6. The CCP Arts Academy also includes the following trainings:
 - a. CCP National Rondalla Workshop scheduled on April 23–28, 2018 (Deadline of submission of application: March 22, 2018),
 - b. CCP Choral Workshop on May 29–June 2, 2018, (Deadline of submission of application: March 22, 2018),
 - c. National Folk Dance Workshop by the Philippine Folk Dance Society on May 21–25, 2018 at the San Jose de Buenavista, Antique, and
 - d. Ballet Philippines Workshop on May 1–27, 2018, (4 weeks)
7. The applicants must submit the following on or before March 16, 2018:
 - a. Completed application form provided in the enclosure; and
 - b. Portfolio of the following to determine appropriateness of level:
 - i. List of the most recent productions/exhibits mounted;
 - ii. List of the most recent major arts festivals at the local, national, and international events attended/participated;
 - iii. List of arts related awards and recognitions received;
 - iv. List and contact number of artists and artist groups that the teachers worked with (for reference purposes);
 - v. Copy of *Sining sa Eskwela*, 2017 CCP Summer Arts Academy, and other recognized training certificates as proof of attendance on arts training programs; and
 - vi. Bank deposit slip.
8. For the CCP Summer Arts Academy offerings in Silliman University, each accepted applicant shall be charged with the following options:
 - a. Registration Fee for only P3,500.00;
 - b. Package Fee (Registration, Food, Accommodation) for P6,500.00;
 - c. Registration, transportation, board and lodging and other expenses shall be charged to School MOOE/Division/Region funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations; and
