1. In line with the preparation for the opening of classes for school year 2019-2020, the Brigada Eskwela is scheduled on May 20-25, 2019.
2. The Regional Kick-off will be on May 16, 2019 in Anibongan National High School, Lianga, Surigao del Sur.
3. All Schools Division Superintendents and all members of the Brigada Eskwela Regional Monitoring Team are required to join the Brigada Eskwela Regional Kick-Off.
4. The Regional Brigada Eskwela Monitoring Team will conduct monitoring of the Brigada Eskwela activities of the different SDOs from May 20-25, 2019.
5. Monitoring of Brigada Eskwela will focus on the ff:
 - a. Cleanliness of the school campus;
 - b. School safety (perimeter fence);
 - c. Demolition of hazardous and illegal structures within the school premises;
 - d. Rehabilitation and de-clogging of drainage canals;
 - e. Check the functionality of toilets and wash areas;
 - f. Repair of learners' chairs/desks; and
 - g. Preparation of learner materials.

7. Travelling expenses of the participants shall be charged against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
