The National Privacy Commission (NPC) in partnership with the Department of Information, Communications and Technology (DICT) intends to hold an orientation on Compliance with the Republic Act 10173 also known as Data Privacy Act of 2012. The event seeks to provide a venue where LGUs, NGAs, Academe and Private Sector can familiarize themselves with the fundamental data privacy principles, the data privacy law and its implementing rules, as well as with the administrative policies issued by the Commission. Together, they aim to facilitate better delivery of government services, in pursuit of nation-building.

Through the roadshows, the NPC hopes to establish a network of cooperation among all local government units that will pledge loyalty to the highest standards of data privacy, in line with the trust ascribed to them by the Filipino people.
