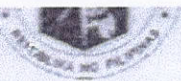

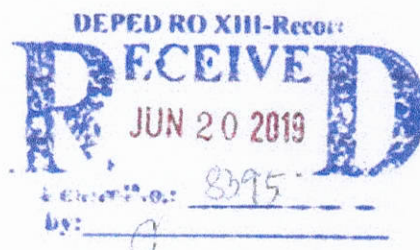

The Department of Education, through the Bureau of Learning Delivery – Teaching and Learning Division (BLD-TLD) shall conduct the Mid-Year Program Implementation Review with CLMD and CID Chiefs with the theme: *“Responding to the Call of SDG 4 Through Strengthened Advocacy for System-Wide Focus on Literacy in the 21st Century”* on July 17-19, 2019 at the Dakak Beach Resort, Dapitan City, Zamboanga Del Norte. This activity aims to: present status and prospects of regional PPAs, curriculum implementation and assessment, and literacy initiatives; gather best practices on the implementation of different TLD K to 12 PPAs; and develop regional action plans on strengthening advocacy for system-wide focus on learners’ literacy.

Participants to this activity are all CLMD and CID chiefs. Further, a representative from each region is expected to deliver a presentation on initiatives for increasing learners’ literacy skills on Day 2 (July 18).
