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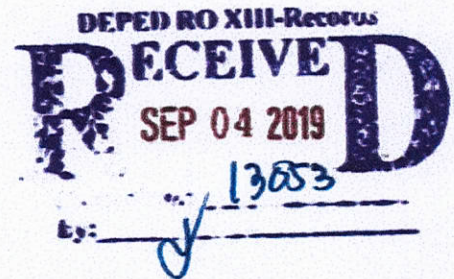

Dear **Director Bringas**:

Greetings!

Once again, the Department of Agriculture (DA) joins the whole world in celebrating World Food Day with this year's theme *"Our actions are our Future. #Healthy diets for a #ZeroHunger world."*

As part of the celebration, DA will again be conducting the annual On-the-Spot Poster Making Contest for elementary students.

With this, we would like to once again seek your support for the success of the conduct of this activity by inviting one participant per division to take part in the Regional conduct of the contest.

Further, we would like to request for the schools' divisions to conduct an elimination round at their level. The winners in the divisions shall then compete in the regional level of the On-the-Spot Poster Making contest.

The contest will be conducted on September 26, 2019. Venue to be finalized and announced soon. Registration will start at 8 o'clock in the morning of the said day. Participants from distant places particularly from the Division of Agusan del Sur, Surigao City, Surigao del Norte, Siargao Island, Province of Dinagat Islands, Tandag, Surigao del Sur, and Bislig will have free accommodation the night before the contest to ensure their participants' are not too weary from travel during the contest.

The winning poster will then be the region's official entry to the national level of the contest.

The following is the set of guidelines for the said event:

I. General Provisions

The following are the general provisions for the On-the-Spot Poster Making Contest:

1. The contest is open to all Grades IV to VI elementary pupils enrolled in any public and DepEd-accredited private schools nationwide. Previous national winners of this contest need not join.
2. Only one (1) contestant per region, endorsed by the Regional On-the-Spot Poster Making Contest Committee will be qualified to join the National On-the-Spot Poster Making Contest.

3. Students shall be allowed to have one (1) coach and one (1) guardian.
4. The poster making contest shall be conducted on-the-spot at the regional and national levels.
5. Contestants are not allowed to bring their own materials. Materials to be used for the Poster Making Contest shall be limited to an illustration board (20" x 30"), eight (8) color oil pastel (i.e. red, orange, yellow, green, blue, violet, brown, black) and pentel pen to be provided by the Contest Committee during the regional and national contests.
6. The poster should be an original creation of the contestant depicting the given theme of the contest, which will be written outside, and not incorporated in the artwork. Contestants who will not follow instructions will automatically be disqualified.
7. Judging shall immediate commence after all entries have been submitted. Coaches, guardians and participants will not be allowed to enter the contest venue while evaluation of the Board of Judges is on-going.
8. The decision of the BOJ shall be final and irrevocable. However, if the winner has been proven to commit any misconduct (i.e. plagiarism, or any form of cheating) , the title and the prize shall be withdrawn.
9. All entries shall become the property of the DA and FAO.
10. Winning entries will be displayed during the culminating activities of the WFD Celebration on October 16, 2019 at the Liwasang Aurora Memorial Circle, Elliptical Road, Diliman, Quezon City. Best Posters will be awarded on the same event.
11. Winners of the Best Poster will receive a cash prize, trophy, and certificate of recognition.

II. Criteria for Judging:

The Board of Judges (BOJ) shall preside this adjudication of entries based on the following criteria:

Creativity and presentation	40%
Relevance to the theme	40%
Originality	20%
Total	100%
