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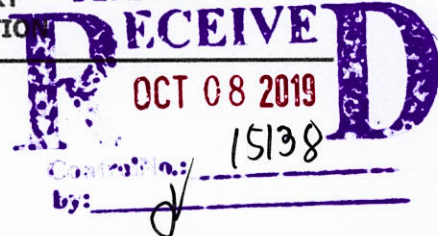

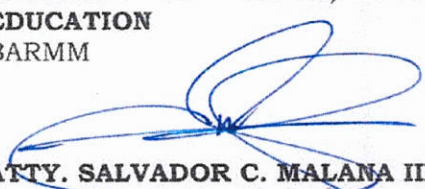

4. Arrival and check-in is on **November 19, 2019**. Registration of participants starts at 1:00 pm (lunch will be served), and hotel check-in is at 2:00pm.
5. They are expected to arrive before lunch on November 19 in time for the Opening Program at 1:30 pm and the actual training will start immediately. Participants who will check-in before November 19 will be billed separately;
6. Check-out is on **November 22, 2019** after breakfast;
