Date: 03 October 2018

Agriculture is one of the learning areas under the Technical-Vocational Livelihood (TVL) Track that covers specializations, such as, Agricultural Crop Production and Organic Agriculture. These specializations are highly responsive to the increasing demand of industries for agriculture workers, replacing the ageing population by new blood of farmers who will soon take part in the economic growth and development of the country.

Sustainable rice production is one of the critical activities that should be focused on by the government. The DepEd-BCD commits itself to actively engage the agriculture teachers in developing among the young farmers with relevant skills and competencies and technology on rice farming. Further, given the right technology on rice farming, teachers shall be able to bring back the interest and love for agriculture among our students.

In recent years, some of our agriculture teachers have been the recipients of the training programs on Infomediary and Climate Smart Agriculture. The BCD highly appreciates these forms of interventions as these contributed to better teaching farming practices that led to sustainable agriculture.

The DepEd-BCD, in collaboration with the Philippine Rice Research Institute in Maligaya, Science City of Munoz shall conduct a 2-cluster 5-day Rice Production Training at PhilRice Central Experiment Station, Science City of Munoz on November 12-16 and November 19-23, respectively, with 45 participants each. Agricultural teachers will be trained on rice morphology and growth stages; farm machinery operations; palay check system; nutrient, pest, water and harvest management; including hands-on practicum.
