This Region

1. Attached is DepEd Memorandum DM-CI-2019-00 from Director Diosdado M. San Antonio, Office of the Undersecretary for Curriculum and Instruction, entitled, **Qualified Applicants for DOST-SEI Scholarship** informing that the Department of Science and Technology has been providing scholarship programs for DepEd personnel. Two of which are the **Capacity Building Program in Science and Mathematics Education (CBPSME)** and the **Science and Technology Regional Alliance of Universities for Inclusive National Development (STRAND)**.
2. In accordance to DepEd Order no. 68, s. 2009 - Scholarship and Training Grant/ Fellowship Pool, only those potential scholars who have served **at least 5 years in service** and with **Very Satisfactory** performance for the last two years will **be allowed** to file for **Official Time** for the duration of their scholarship.
3. The number of years shall be the difference between the date of application, as indicated in the form submitted, and first day of service as a permanent employee.
4. Filing for the aforementioned programs, applicants must attach the following:
 - a. Permit to Study signed by the School Division Superintendent (SDS) and Regional Director;
 - and
 - b. Letter of Appointment or Service Record to verify the years of service in DepEd.

The Department of Science and Technology (DOST), through the Science Education Institute (SEI) has been providing graduate scholarship programs for DepEd personnel. Two of which are the Capacity Building Program in Science and Mathematics Education (CBPSME) and the Science and Technology Regional Alliance of Universities for Inclusive National Development (STRAND).

Both are national consortium scholarship programs for masters and doctorate degrees in science and mathematics education. CBPSME aims to improve the quality of education and accelerate the development of critical mass experts in Science and Mathematics, while STRAND aims to reach out and support the higher education institutions in the provinces which need to be strengthened in terms of developing human resource capabilities.

Last 12 July 2018, the Department of Education (DepEd) entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with DOST to enable its teaching and non-teaching personnel who will avail of the CBPSME.

In accordance to this, DepEd reviews and validates the list of qualified scholars based on the Department Order 68 s. 2009 - *Scholarship and Training Grant/Fellowship Pool* which states that potential scholars must have been in the service for *at least 5 years*, with at least very satisfactory performance for the last two years. The difference between their date of application, as indicated in the form submitted, and first day of service as a permanent employee, is used in determining their number of years in DepEd.

In connection with this, only those potential scholars who have served at least 5 years in service with very satisfactory performance for the last two (2) years will be allowed to file their Official Time for the duration of their scholarship. In filing for Official Time for the above-mentioned programs, applicants must attach the following: (1) Permit to Study signed by the School Division Superintendent (SDS) and Regional Director. (2) Letter of Appointment or Service Record to verify the years of service in DepEd.

TERMS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

An awardee shall:

- enroll in the required academic load per semester and study full-time/part-time in any of the identified training institutions;
- maintain a grade point average/general weighted average required by the Graduate School of the university and comply with the university's academic requirements to remain in the scholarship program;
- comply with the terms and conditions of the Scholarship Contract to be entered into among himself/herself, the DOST-SEI, and the Training Institution;
- render service in the Philippines upon completion of the degree along the field of specialization equivalent to the length of time the scholarship is enjoyed;
- receive the remaining stipends to be released as incentive if the degree program is completed earlier than the prescribed period of study;
- refund the scholarship grant with 12% interest for non-completion of the program within the prescribed period of study and/or failure to comply with the service obligation.

SELECTION OF AWARDEES

- Member-university screens and evaluates the accomplished application form and requirements of the applicant.
- University endorses the potential list of qualifiers to SEI.
- DOST-SEI endorses to DepEd the list of names of potential qualifiers from DepEd who are teaching and non-teaching personnel with seven (7) or more years in service.
- DepEd issues potential qualifier Certification re-Permit to go on Leave with Compensation.
- DepEd endorses to DOST-SEI the list of qualified DepEd teachers and non-teaching personnel for final approval of the DOST Secretary.
- Upon approval of the DOST Secretary, the list of awardees is final and unappealable.
- DOST-SEI, through the Consortium Project Directors, sends the notice of award to the awardees.

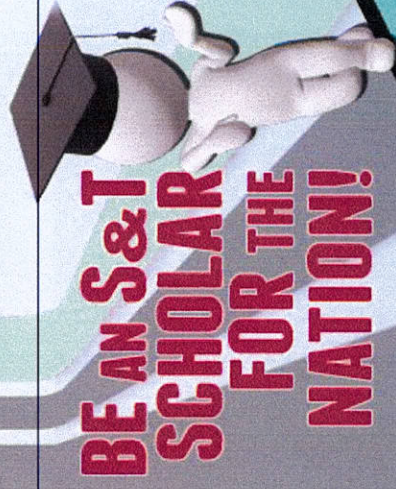

CRITERIA OF ELIGIBILITY

1. Natural-born Filipino citizen;
2. Not be more than 45 years old at the time of application;
3. Be in good health and of good moral character;
4. Pass the admission requirements for graduate studies at any of the consortium member-universities;
5. Have at least two years teaching experience in science and mathematics for PhD; or at least one year teaching experience or have graduated with academic honors or graduated as DOST scholar for Master's;

- 6.a If employed: Be allowed to study full-time for two or three years (Residential Mode) and part-time for six years at UPOU (Distance Education Mode);
- 6.b For employees of the DepEd, signed Form 2A by the school Division Superintendent and Regional Director.
- 6.c For employed non DepEd applicants, signed Form 2B by the Head of the University.
7. Not be a recipient of other scholarship;
8. Be willing to accept the terms and conditions specified in the Scholarship Contract.

2. Photocopy of Birth Certificate;
3. If employed, Certification of Employment and Permit to Study, (Form 2);
4. Medical Certificate (Form 3);
5. Certified True Copy of Service Record, if employed;
6. Certified True Copy of Official Transcript of Records (TOR);
7. Notice of Admission to the Master's/PhD in Science and Mathematics Education program in the Graduate School at any of the identified universities;
8. Endorsement from two (2) former professors;
9. Letter of nomination/recommendation from the head of the university.
