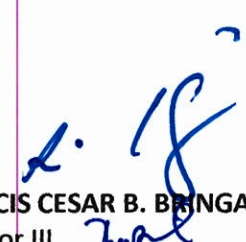

1. The Department of Education Caraga Region through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) shall conduct a **Writeshop on the Design, Selection, Organization and Utilization of Assessment Strategies for Asatidz Teaching Arabic Language and Islamic Values Education (ALIVE) Classes under the Madrasah Education Program (MEP)** on **December 16-20, 2019 at Siargao** (specific venue still to be determined).
2. The training workshop aims to capacitate asatidz to develop quarterly test questions and Arabic Language Reading Assessment Tool for K to 3 Arabic Language and Islamic Values Education (ALIVE) learners. Specifically, the training aims to capacitate asatidz to:
 - 2.1. develop deeper understanding on classroom assessment;
 - 2.2. familiarize the principles and methods of test construction;
 - 2.3. develop test questions for quarterly examinations consistent with the curriculum requirements;
 - 2.4. develop grade-level appropriate reading assessment tool in Arabic Language.

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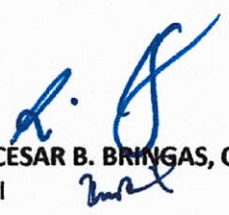
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speakers and Program Management Team shall be charged to MEP Funds subject to the usual government accounting rules and regulations.
