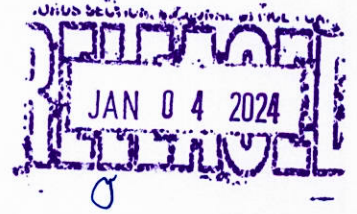

Guidelines for Regional Presentation

I. 2023 Accomplishment of the Regions

A. Plenary Session

1. Each region shall prepare its 2023 Accomplishment Report which will be presented during the Plenary Session.
2. The 2023 Accomplishment Report shall include, but not be limited to, programs, projects, and activities on the implementation of the Alternative Learning System initiated by the regions and their respective division offices.
3. The report should be in a powerpoint presentation not to exceed five (5) slides using the provided template.
4. Each region will be given 15 minutes to present the 2023 Accomplishment Reports.
5. The Regional ALS Focal Person shall submit to BAE the softcopy of the regional report during the registration on January 16, 2024.

II. Sharing of Best Practices (Break-out Sessions)

1. Each region will be given a chance to share its **best practices** in all of the topics with the requirements given below.

Topic	Description/Requirement	No. of Presentation	Time allotment
Implementation of ALS SHS	Successful implementation of ALS SHS in a schools division	1	20mins
Support of Partners on ALS Implementation	Innovation or unique program/project that is supported by a partner (e.g., LGUs, NGOs, Private Organizations) in the implementation of the ALS Program in the region/division.	1	20mins
Initiatives on ALS CLC Construction	Initiatives on the construction of ALS CLC which is funded by partners.	1	20mins
Teacher Training Program Initiatives of ALS Teachers	Training Program initiatives provided for ALS Teachers	1	20mins

2. The presentation can be a video or a powerpoint presentation which shall be presented during the break-out sessions by either the Regional ALS Focal Person or the Division ALS Focal Person.
3. The presentation shall not exceed the provided time allotment and the number of participants.
