MANDATORY ASSESSMENT FOR CERTIFICATION OF SENIOR
HIGH SCHOOL - TECHNICAL VOCATIONAL LIVELIHOOD
(SHS-TVL) GRADE 12 LEARNERS

1. The enhanced K to 12 Program emphasizes the development of holistically developed individuals who are equipped with the necessary knowledge, skills, and attitudes to become productive citizens. The Technical Vocational Livelihood (TVL) track aims to provide learners with technical and vocational skills that are relevant to the industry and aligned with Philippine Qualifications Framework (PQF).
2. The National Competency Assessment (NCA), is a crucial component of the TVL curriculum, ensuring that learners have acquired the necessary competencies to meet industry standards and become employable. It serves as a validation of their skills and knowledge, providing them with a nationally recognized certification that enhances their career prospects.
3. In line with this, all Grade 12 learners enrolled in any of the TVL strands for SY 2024 -2025 who are not recipients of the Joint Delivery Voucher Program (JDVP) are required to undergo the NCA. This will be conducted in accordance with the guidelines set forth by TESDA, as outlined in the Joint Memorandum Circular (JMC).
4. The assessment shall be conducted for **FREE** at designated TESDA Assessment Centers in the Provincial Offices. Successful completion of the NCA will result in the issuance of a National Certificate of Competency (NC II) by TESDA.
5. Each School Division Office (SDO) must ensure that learners are properly endorsed, submit the complete required documents to their respective TESDA Provincial Offices (POs), and provide learners with proper orientation on the assessment requirements. Learners should be accompanied by the teachers concerned during the whole duration of the activity.
6. Division Education Program Supervisor in TVL is required to submit weekly status report on the results of the assessment starting March 14, 2025 using the attached template.

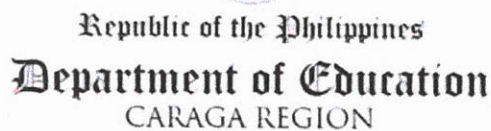
