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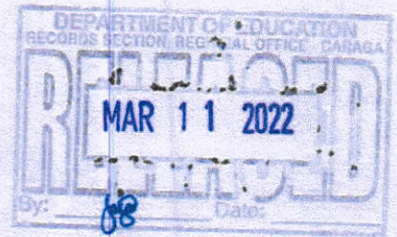

PARTICIPATION IN THE WORKSHOP ON PLANNING AND PROGRAM

EDUCATION PROGRAM (MEP)

1. The Bureau of Learning Delivery- Student Inclusion Division (BLD-SID) will hold a Workshop on Planning and Program Implementation Review (PIR) on Madrasah Education Program (MEP) for Mindanao Cluster on March 23-25, 2022 to be hosted by Butuan City Division. 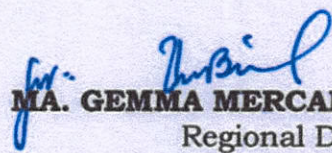
