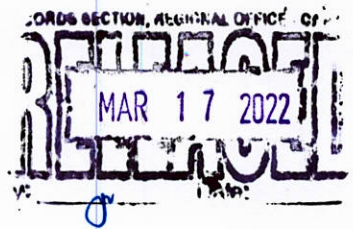

SUBJECT : **LAUNCHING OF THE "MASHSIGABONG TAGUMPAY SA TRABAHO AT NEGOSYO PINANDAY: THE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATE SUCCESS STORIES"**

DATE : January 26, 2022

The Department of Education (DepEd), through the initiative of the Bureau of Curriculum Development (BCD), has conducted the National Tracer Study of the Senior High School (SHS) Graduates for SY 2017–2018. It revealed that about 10% of graduate-respondents were employed, where 7% of which were SHS TVL graduates and 3% were SHS Academic graduates. In addition, the study also showed that nearly 83% were in higher education while only one 1% was engaged in entrepreneurship.

As DepEd continues to promote the SHS curriculum exits, the Office of the Undersecretary for Curriculum and Instruction (OUCI) through the BCD, will launch the "**MaSHSigabong Tagumpay sa Trabaho at Negosyo Pinanday: The SHS Graduates Success Stories**" on March 16, 2022, and feature the success stories of graduates through individual videos and narratives on the DepEd's Official website - DepEd Philippines YouTube Channel, DepEd Philippines Facebook Page and other official social media platforms from March 17, 2022 to April 8, 2022.

The objectives are:

1. To showcase success stories of graduates who are gainfully employed and excelling in entrepreneurship as exits of the SHS Program;
2. To advocate the SHS Program and the SHS exits;

3. To inspire the SHS students and graduates to be successful in their respective SHS exits;
4. To promote collaboration among internal and external stakeholders for the success of the SHS Graduates; and
5. To gain support from communities and industries in duplicating the success among SHS graduates.

These success stories of SHS graduates are divided into four categories:

Category 1: SHS TVL graduates who are gainfully employed

Category 2: SHS TVL graduates who are entrepreneurs

Category 3: SHS Academic, Arts and Design, or Sports graduates who are gainfully employed

Category 4: SHS Academic, Arts and Design, or Sports graduates who are entrepreneurs

The following are the criteria used for the selection of SHS Graduate Success Stories:

- The two (2) success stories must come from the batches of SHS graduates
- The two (2) SHS graduates must have exhibited good moral character and must not have been charged of any administrative, civil or criminal case
- The success stories are exemplary, worth emulating and inspiring
