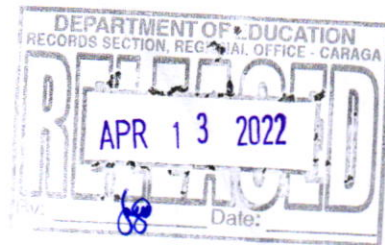

SUBMISSION OF RADaRs DUE TO TD "AGATON"

1. As of today, April 12, 2022, at 8:00AM, PAGASA-Caraga informed that the center of the Tropical Depression "Agaton" is already in the vicinity of Marabut, Samar with Tropical Cyclone Wind Signal No. 1 for the areas in Dinagat Islands, expecting only minimal to minor threat to life and property and light to moderate with at times heavy rains. Due to the combined effects of land interaction, increasing vertical wind shear, and the effects of the upper-level outflow of Severe Tropical Storm "Malakas", this tropical depression is forecast to deteriorate into a remnant low within the next 24 hours.
2. In view of the foregoing, affected SDOs shall immediately submit a validated Rapid Assessment of Damages Report (RADaR) to the regional office thru email add: megnon.beldad@deped.gov.ph, detailing damages or effects brought by the TD "Agaton" with SDS-signed PDF and Excel/editable versions for consolidation, review, and subsequent submission to DepEd-DRRMS.
3. Meanwhile, the Mines and Geosciences Bureau (MGB) also requests the public to be aware of the geohazards in their areas. To check out on MGB maps, access the tinyurl.com/MGB-Geohazard-Portal and other platforms such as DOST-PHIVOLCS' HazardHunterPH (hazardhunter.georisk.gov.ph) for details.
