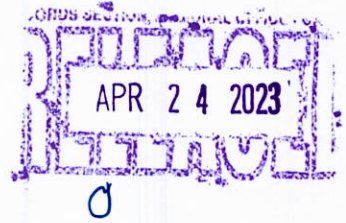

TRAINING OF ALS TEACHERS ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE
CONTEXTUALIZED MOST ESSENTIAL LEARNING COMPETENCIES
(MELCS)-BASED ALTERNATIVE LEARNING SYSTEM
SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL CURRICULUM

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum OM-OAGA-2022-00129, the Department of Education Caraga Region, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), shall conduct the Training of ALS Teachers on the Implementation of the Contextualized Most Essential Learning Competencies (MELCS)-Based Alternative Learning System Senior High School Curriculum on April 29 to May 2, 2023 at the Balanghai Hotel and Convention Center, Butuan City.
2. The training aims the participants to:
 - a. Develop deep understanding, familiarization, and appreciation of the contextualized MELCs-based ALS SHS Curriculum among ALS teachers;
 - b. Train and equip the ALS division core of trainers with the skills needed for the delivery and contextualization process of learning competencies in the ALS context; and
 - c. Conduct demonstration teaching with select teacher participants in preparation for the implementation of the contextualized MELCs-based ALS SHS Curriculum in their respective school divisions, districts, and schools.
3. Participants in this activity are the Division ALS Focal Persons, select ALS SHS Teachers from the formal school, forty trainers, and the program management team, which can be found in Enclosure No. 1. All participants are required to complete the online registration on or before April 25, 2023 through this link:

4. Check in and registration at the venue on Day 1 (April 29, 2023), Saturday, from 7:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m., and present the approved travel authority. The opening program will start at 1:00 p.m. Lunch will be served as the first meal on the same date, and the last meal will be a packed snack on the last day.
6. Participants with health concerns or maintenance shall bring with them their medicine sufficient for the entire duration of the training.
7. Meals, accomodations, supplies, and materials for participants shall be charged against training funds. Travel expenditures for all participants and officials shall be charged against the ALS PSF, MOOE, local funds, SEF, and other sources of money, according to the standard accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
