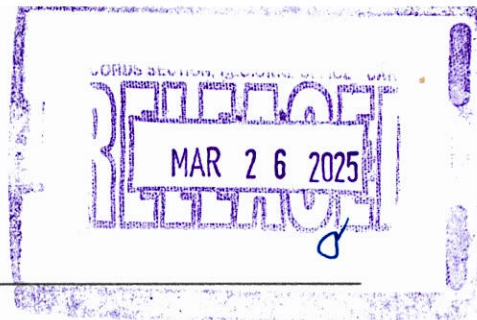

SELECT ACTION AND BASIC RESEARCH PROPOSALS FOR FUNDING UNDER
BASIC EDUCATION RESEARCH FUND (BERF)

1. The Regional Research Committee (RRC) has approved basic research proposals and confirmed action research proposals for funding under BERF. The list of select action and basic research proposals, along with the corresponding amounts granted, is attached as **Enclosure 1**.
2. Proponents of the approved research proposals shall submit the final cost estimates to the Division Research Coordinator, including the required deliverables, to the Schools Division Office (SDO) Accounting Unit for the release of funds.
3. The Division Research Coordinator shall conduct an orientation with the research proponents to ensure awareness and understanding of the policies on the research program, particularly on liquidation requirements.
4. Other research proposals that were not approved for BERF funding but passed the research evaluation by the RRC may be funded through other sources. The list of research proposals that passed the evaluation is attached as **Enclosure 2**.
5. The monitoring of research implementation shall be part of the Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) Plan of the division office, as indicated in the Regional Implementation Guidelines in Research, to ensure accuracy in gathering and analysis of data.
6. The needs of researchers shall be incorporated into the Division Technical Assistance Plan (DTAP) of the division office. Concerned subject experts, in coordination with the Research Coordinator, shall provide technical assistance to teacher-researchers in conducting their study.
7. The Sub-Allotment Release Order (SARO) shall be issued to the SDO.
8. A Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the proponent(s) and the superintendent shall be prepared by the Division Research Coordinator.
9. Funds shall be released to the research proponents before the research implementation to prevent delays in the completion of the study.
10. In adherence to cash-based budgeting, the implementation of basic research shall be completed no later than November 2025.

11. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is highly desired.
