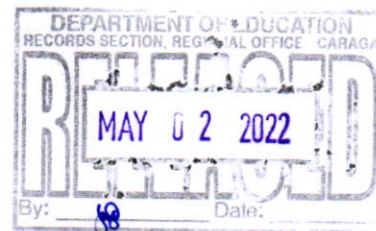

5. The judging for the regional level will be on May 8, 2022.

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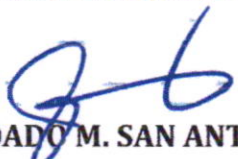
