TRANSITION MONITORING AND SUPPORT RAPID SURVEY ON THE FULL
IMPLEMENTATION OF THE STRENGTHENED SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL
CURRICULUM IN PRIVATE BASIC EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 12, s. 2026, the Department of Education (DepEd), through the Private Education Office (PEO), will conduct a Transition Monitoring and Support Rapid Survey for private basic education institutions (PBEIs) to help facilitate a smooth shift to the full implementation of the Strengthened Senior High School (SSHS) Curriculum in SY 2026-2027.
2. The rapid survey has been designed to:
 - a. Identify support needs: Determine specific areas where PBEIs may require technical and administrative assistance (e.g. curriculum mapping, industry linkaging);
 - b. Monitor readiness: Capture an accurate baseline of institutional readiness; and
 - c. Manage workforce transition: Understand the implications on private school faculty to better inform mitigating strategies and support measures.
3. All schools division offices are directed to promptly disseminate this request to all PBEIs offering the SHS program within their jurisdiction by requiring the private SHSs to submit the requested data by filling out the form through this link: **[https://tinyurl.com /Private SSHS-Survey](https://tinyurl.com/Private_SSHS-Survey)** on or before **April 30, 2026**.
