**ORIENTATION ON THE LEARNING SYSTEMS REFORM POLICIES FOR SCHOOLS

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3. To support the efficient implementation and consistent messaging, the roles and responsibilities of the Regional Office and the Schools Division Offices (SDOs) are presented below:

2. Facilitates the financial requirements (downloading, etc.) for the orientation	2. Organize a “Clustered Viewing Session” at a specific venue

4. Monitors the participation of SDOs during the orientation	4. Submits documentation report (only the number) of school heads and teachers attended, and photos (centralized viewing session)
5. Consolidates report for submission to CO
