CONTINUATION OF THE IN-HOUSE TRAINING FOR THE PALARONG PAMBANSA
2026 QUALIFIERS AND SEND-OFF PROGRAM

1. In preparation for the upcoming Palarong Pambansa 2026, this Office announces the continuation of the in-house training for all qualified athletes, as well as the conduct of the Send-off Program, in accordance with the approved schedule and designated venues.
2. This activity aims to ensure athletes' optimal performance through sustained training and effective coordination, while providing official recognition and support to the delegations prior to their participation in the national competition.
3. Starting **May 8, 2026**, all delegations shall transfer to **Bayugan Comprehensive National High School (BCHNS)** as the main billeting quarter. However, specific events shall remain in their designated billeting quarters, as follows:
 - a. Athletics and Swimming – Athletes' Dug-Out, Patin-ay, Prosperidad, Agusan del Sur
 - b. Archery and Table Tennis – Labnig Elementary School, Talacogon, Agusan del Sur
 - c. Boxing –Verdu Elementary School, Bayugan City
4. All Schools Division Offices are hereby directed to take full responsibility for the transportation of their respective delegations to BCHNS and other assigned venues, ensuring safety, order, and punctuality.
5. The in-house training period shall conclude on **May 19, 2026**.
6. In addition, a **Send-Off Program** shall be conducted on **May 11, 2026**, with the following schedule and activities:

7. All Schools Division Superintendents, Regional Office Chiefs, Regional Sports Officer, Division Sports Officers, Training Directors, and all members of the delegations are enjoined to attend and actively participate in the said activities.
8. Travel expenses of all participants shall be charged to local funds subject to the existing government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
