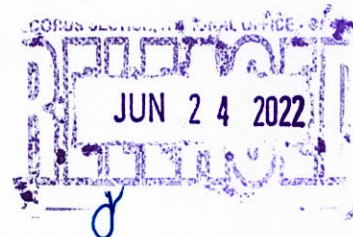

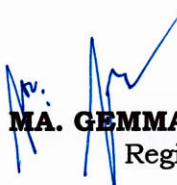

HOMEROOM GUIDANCE CURRICULUM

DATE : June 13, 2022

The Curriculum and Instruction Strand through the Bureau of Curriculum Development will conduct an *Online Workshop on the Validation of the Refined Homeroom Guidance Curriculum* on July 4-8, 2022 via Zoom.

This activity aims to:

- examine the formulated key stage content standards, performance standards, and content per quarter including the learning competencies for Kindergarten-Grade 12;
- scrutinize the spiral progression and developmental appropriateness of the Curriculum Guide; and
- check the alignment of the Curriculum Guide based on the domains, non-negotiable concepts, and life skills to be developed.

All regions are requested to send **two (2) participants** for this activity referring to the following criteria:

The curriculum guide validator:

- must possess at least a master's degree aligned with the discipline of the learning area;
- must have at least 15-years experience teaching the discipline aligned with the assigned learning area;

3. has excellent writing skills and background knowledge of the K to 12 Curriculum Guide content (especially content and performance standards and competencies) and format;
4. must have at least 10 years of experience in writing any books, journals, or reading resources aligned with his/her discipline published either in the division, region, or national level; and
5. must not be involved in any publishing institutions or book distributors during the development process.

The Validators are expected to:

1. submit all the required documents including the Non-Disclosure Agreement relevant to the activities;
2. attend meetings and activities on validating the Curriculum Guide based on the agreed timeline;
3. gather the required inputs from the co-writer and lead person (only if applicable);
4. ensure timely and systematic collaboration with the team/ grade level;
5. maintain the confidentiality of all materials used in the activities including the outputs;
6. discuss concerns or issues arising in validating the Curriculum Guide to the assigned Lead Person per key stage (if applicable);
7. complete the assigned task promptly; and
8. perform other tasks relevant to the completion of the Curriculum Guide.

All participants are expected to join the workshop on official time to observe the remote and flexible work arrangements in the Department of Education during the Imposition of Alert Level 1 System for Covid-19 Response:

11. *Remote and flexible work arrangements as prescribed in CSC MC 18, s. 2020, Amendment to the Revised Interim Guidelines for Alternative Work Arrangements and Support Mechanisms for Workers in the Government during the Period of State of Public Health Emergency due to COVID-19 Pandemic and DepEd Order (DO) No. 011, s. 2020 titled Revised Guidelines on Alternative Work Arrangements in the Department of Education During the Period of State of National Emergency Due to COVID-19 Pandemic may be adopted, as deemed appropriate and insofar as practicable, in accordance with the required onsite capacity depending on the prevailing COVID-19 alert level in the locality where the office/school/ CLC is located*

Since this workshop will be held on an online platform, the participants can work effectively and with ease in a place where there is a stable internet connection. If there will be concerns with internet connectivity, the participants may coordinate with their respective EsP Division Supervisors for further assistance.
