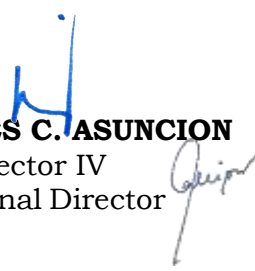

We deeply appreciate for your strong support, collaboration and continuing involvement in this academic endeavor.

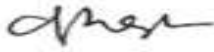
