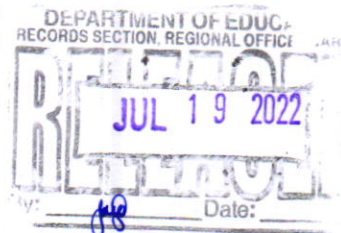

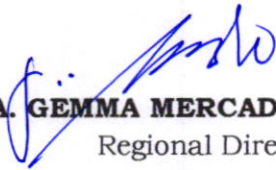

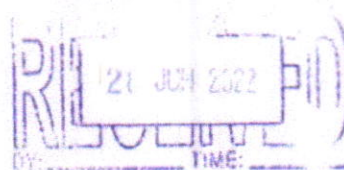
The 2022 CCP Arts Academy is especially designed to provide teachers (non-beginners) with professional and specialized training on their respective art forms, build their capacities and advance their artistic development by focusing on production and performance techniques, principles/processes, arts knowledge and skills, and pedagogical approaches. Only 30 teachers will be accepted per module.

Preference will be given to teacher-applicants who are actively engaged with creative and artistic/management productions/activities by mounting artistic productions/exhibition, attending major arts festivals (national and international) and winning artistic awards and recognitions, or to those who are actively engaged in mentoring/coaching students in the arts, for recent competitions such as National Music Competition for Young Artists (NAMCYA), National Festival of Talents (NFOT) and other national and international competitions/exhibitions in the different fields of art.
