AND COACHING FOR EXCELLENCE TRAINING (MORCET)

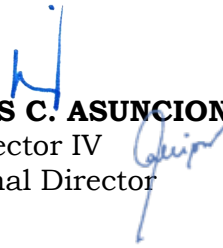
1. The Department of Education – Caraga Region has received information from the Mathematical Society of the Philippines - Caraga Chapter (MSP-Caraga) regarding their **2025 MSP-Caraga Mathematics Olympiad Readiness and Coaching for Excellence Training (MORCET)** to be conducted on **August 3, 10, and 17, 2025**, via Google Meet.
2. Based on the communication from MSP-Caraga, the training aims to:
 - a. enhance the mathematical problem-solving skills of coaches and contestants in preparation for the Philippine Mathematical Olympiad (PMO) and other mathematics competitions;
 - b. train coaches in effective strategies for guiding students through Olympiad-level problems;
 - c. foster collaboration between students and coaches in preparation for national and international mathematical competitions; and
 - d. deepen the understanding of mathematical concepts in advanced problem areas such as algebra, geometry, number theory, and combinatorics.
3. Attached herewith is the official letter dated June 6, 2025, from Dr. Cheryl Q. Mentuda, Chair of the 2025 MSP-Caraga MORCET, and Dr. Jenny C. Cano, President of MSP-Caraga, which contains the complete documentation such as general information of the organization, SEC registration certificate, and the detailed Program, Project, Activity (PPA) Profile.
4. Participation in the MORCET is entirely **voluntary and subject to the discretion and approval of parents/guardians, concerned School Heads, and Schools Division Superintendent**. Any decision to participate shall be made independently by the parties involved and does not require endorsement or recommendation from this office.
5. In accordance with Republic Act No. 5546, no collections, contributions, or registration fees shall be solicited from students, teachers, or parents by any DepEd personnel or office in connection with this training. This memorandum serves purely

as information dissemination and does not constitute endorsement of MSP-Caraga or its activities per DepEd Order No. 28, s. 2001.

We, all of whom are residents of the Philippines, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-stock corporation under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines.

AND TO HEREBY CERTIFY:

FIRST. - That the name of the said corporation shall be ~~THE~~ "MATHEMATICAL SOCIETY OF THE PHILIPPINES", Inc.

SECOND. - That the purpose for which such corporation is formed are:

(a) To promote the advancement of mathematical science in the Philippines;
