MONITORING FOR THE ROLL-OUT IMPLEMENTATION OF LEARNER RIGHTS AND PROTECTION (LRP) ON WHEELS AND BULLYING PREVENTION CARAVAN DEVELOPMENT OF KINDNESS AND EMPATHY

1. To ensure the protection and upholding of learners' rights across the Philippines, the Learner Rights and Protection Office (LRPO), will launch the **Learner Rights and Protection on Wheels cum Bullying Prevention Caravan for the Development of Kindness and Empathy** initiative. As part of this continuing commitment, this Office announces the conduct of onsite monitoring for its roll-out implementation in selected schools across 12 Schools Division Offices (SDOs), scheduled from July 18 to August 31, 2025.

2. This initiative aims to raise awareness about educational rights and provide protection services, fostering a safer, inclusive, and learner-friendly environment in schools. It underscores the Department of Education's zero-tolerance policy against all forms of learner abuse, exploitation, violence, discrimination, and bullying, while highlighting the crucial role of Learner Rights and Protection (LRP) policies in basic education.

3. Accordingly, the Regional Learner Rights and Protection Personnel, will conduct monitoring and evaluation in the identified schools between July 18 to August 31, 2025. This monitoring will assess division and school's compliance with the guidelines, ensure implementation meets the standards and requirements, and identify issues and concerns for technical assistance.

4. The activity shall be participated in by select Regional Office and Schools Division Office personnel and LRP Advocates, learners, and teachers at the host school.

5. It is important that classes will not be disrupted during this activity in accordance with DepEd Order No. 09, s. 2005 which institutes measures to increase engaged time-on-task and ensures compliance.
