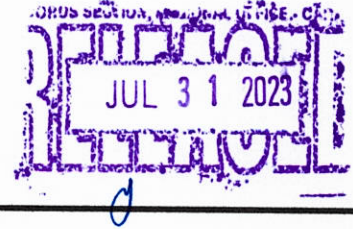

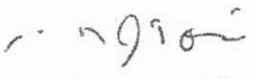

BRIEFER ON THE DEPED'S POSITION ON THE PHILIPPINE QUALIFICATIONS FRAMEWORK (PQF) LEVELS

BACKGROUND AND ISSUE

The **Philippine Qualifications Framework (PQF)** is a national policy which describes the levels of educational qualifications and sets the standards for qualification outcomes. It is a quality assured national system for the development, recognition, and award of qualifications based on standards of knowledge, skills, and values acquired in different ways and methods by learners and workers of a certain country.

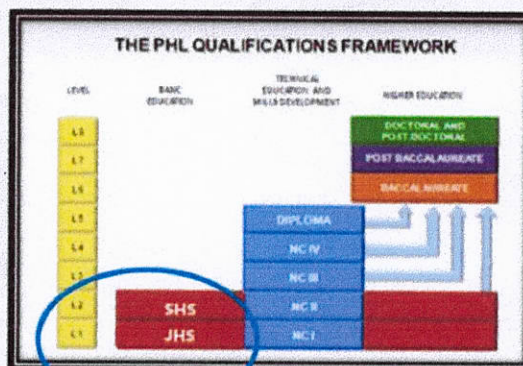
The Institutionalization of the Philippine Qualifications Framework (PQF) through **Executive Order No. 83 Series of 2012** was signed on October 1, 2012. Then, on January 16, 2018, the PQF was passed into law as **RA 10968 or the PQF Act of 2018**. Its IRR was then approved on January 15, 2019.

HOWEVER, THE PQF DOES NOT INCLUDE BASIC EDUCATION IN ANY OF ITS LEVELS.

THE PROPOSAL

It is proposed that the **Junior High School (JHS) certificate** and the **Senior High School (SHS) diploma** be recognized as PQF Level 1 and PQF Level 2, respectively.

THE PHL QUALIFICATIONS FRAMEWORK



QUALIFICATION AS DEFINED IN THE IRR OF THE PQF ACT OF 2018

- ✓ A formal certification that a person has successfully achieved specific learning outcomes relevant to the identified academic, industry or community requirements.
- ✓ A qualification confers official recognition of values in the labor market and in education and training.

These definitions in **SHS diploma** are certifications that attainment of learning performance standards (DepEd Order 31/2 certification likewise proceed to any employment, (2) or and (4) middle level
