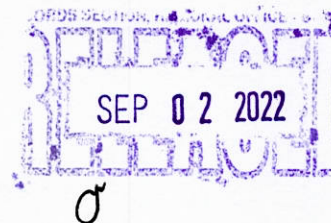

Dear Engr. Andoy,

This refers to your e-mail dated 12 March 2022, requesting for comments for Municipal Ordinance No. 12, Series of 2021 regarding the renaming of Panaosawon Integrated School to Eufemio B. Ariate Integrated School.

Please be reminded that should there be any moves to name or rename public structures in the future, **prior consultation** with the National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP) must be made pursuant to Section 13 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of the Philippines. Otherwise, the validity of the said ordinance may be put into question.

Nonetheless, we are pleased to inform you that the NHCP does not object to the renaming of the school, based on the thorough deliberations of the Sangguniang Bayan of Bayabas and the Local School Board concerned. However, it is recommended that the old name of the school be placed beneath the new name as follows:

EUFEMIO B. ARIATE INTEGRATED SCHOOL
(Formerly Panaosawon Integrated School)

This will preserve the historicity of the old name, and serve as guide to the people who are used to the old name.

Attached is a copy of the NHCP Revised Guidelines on the Naming and Renaming of Streets, Public Schools, Plazas, Buildings, Bridges, and other Public Structures for your reference.

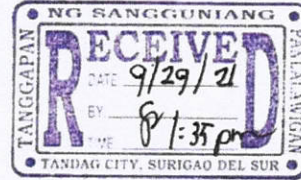

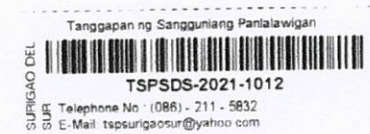
MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 12

Series of 2021

AN ORDINANCE RENAMING THE PANAOSAWON INTEGRATED SCHOOL INTO EUFEMIO B. ARIATE INTEGRATED SCHOOL GIVING HIM THE HONOR AND APPRECIATION FOR HIS DONATED LOT FOR THE SAID SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, there was a Deed of Donation executed by spouses Eufemio B. Ariate and Pelagia Lozada for a 10,000 square meters of land situated in Barangay Panaosawon sometimes in 1962. The said lot is within the 20,000 square meters lot, more or less, located at the northeastern part of the entire parcel under Tax Declaration No. 02-0007-00072 under the name of Eufemio B. Ariate, registered in the Municipal Assessor's Office of the Local Government Unit of Bayabas, Surigao del Sur (LGU-Bayabas, Surigao del Sur);

WHEREAS, it was stated in that Deed of Donation that the said property being donated shall be used exclusively for the school site of the Panaosawon Elementary School and/or for such other purposes which the Municipal Government of Bayabas, Surigao del Sur may deem wise and proper for the benefit and welfare of the people of Panaosawon, Bayabas, Surigao del Sur;

WHEREAS, the Panaosawon Elementary school was now catering secondary education, thus it was named by the Department of Education as Panaosawon Integrated School (PIS) with School ID No. 501275;

WHEREAS, the people of Panaosawon, thru the General Parents, Teachers, and Community Association (GPTCA), clamored that the name of Panaosawon Integrated School be changed into Eufemio B. Ariate Integrated School to give honor and to show respect and appreciation to the donor of the said lot, thus the GPTCA Resolution No. 01, series of 2021 was passed and submitted to the Barangay Council of Panaosawon for favorable consideration;

WHEREAS, the Barangay Council of Panaosawon then passed Resolution No. 18, series of 2021, requesting this Sanggunian to facilitate the renaming of the said school, thus this Ordinance;

WHEREAS, the Local School Board of Bayabas, Surigao del Sur passed Resolution No.04, series of 2021 recommending to rename the Panaosawon Integrated School to Eufemio B. Ariate Integrated School in honor of the generosity and benevolence of the donor of lot of said school in Barangay Panaosawon, Bayabas, Surigao del Sur;

WHEREAS, Section 13, (c), (3) of RA 7160 empowers the Sangguniang Bayan to change the name of municipal public secondary schools within its territorial jurisdiction upon recommendation of the Local School Board and in consultation with National Historical Commission (NHC) of the Philippines;

WHEREAS, under the revised guidelines of the NHC of the Philippines, proposed names of public schools, among others "must have historical and cultural significance and must contribute to the positive development of national pride through the good example exhibited by the name being used;

WHEREAS, after the creation of Barangay Panaosawon in 1961, spouses Eufemio B. Ariate and Pelagia Lozada have unselfishly donated portion of their property to the Municipal Government of Bayabas to be the school site of the said barangay; and

WHEREAS, in honor and great appreciation of their legacy, the Panaosawon Integrated School shall be renamed into Eufemio B. Ariate Integrated School.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bayabas, Surigao del Sur in session assembled that:

Section 1. Short Title. This Ordinance shall be known as the "Ordinance Renaming the Panaosawon Integrated School into Eufemio B. Ariate Integrated School."

Section 3. Supplemental Funds. The supplemental funds necessary for the construction, maintenance, and operation of the said public school, as determined by the Local School Board, shall be taken from the Special Education Funds of Bayabas, Surigao del Sur or from any available funds of the Municipality.

Section 4. Repealing Clause. In case any provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 5. Effectivity. This ordinance shall take effect after affirmation by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and after posting of the same for ten (10) days at the bulletin boards of the seven barangays and in conspicuous places within the Municipality of Bayabas, Surigao del Sur.

ENACTED this 6th day of September, 2021 upon motion of Hon. Elpidio G. Denzo, duly seconded by Hon. Reparato A. Cahatian, Jr.
