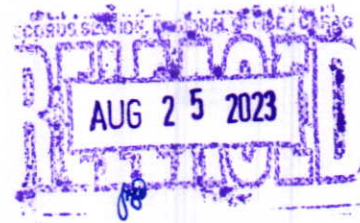

CONDUCT OF THE 2023 DIVISION CLIMATE CHANGE CARAVAN

1. Education is crucial to promote climate action. It helps people understand and address the impacts of the climate crisis, empowering them with the knowledge, skills, values, and attitudes needed to act as agents of change.
2. To continuously intensify the promotion of climate change adaptation and mitigation program of the department and to further strengthen the various projects of the schools on environmental protection, conservation, and preservation, all SDOs are directed to conduct the 2023 Division Climate Change Caravan (DCCC) in schools any day/s from **August to September 2023**.
3. As agreed during the 2nd Quarter DRRM Coordination Meeting in June 2023, SDOs shall conduct their caravan activities anchoring on, but not limited, to the following themes:

6. Sustainable Energy (SE) - Efficient use of energy - Shift to renewable energy	Agusan del Norte
7. Knowledge and Capacity Development (KCD) - Curriculum Integration - Community/MKOs exchange - Co-curricular integration - Training of Personnel	Bislig City Surigao del Sur Tandag City

4. Activities for the Division Climate Change Caravan may focus on any one or more of the following types:

- Development of learning materials with CCAM integration
- Conduct of curricular activities with CCAM Integration
- Conduct of co-curricular activities with CCAM integration
- Conduct of advocacy activities focused on CCAM
- Conduct of training for teachers focused on CCAM
- Development and distribution of IECs on CCAM
- Implementation of policy on CCAM
- Conduct of research on CCAM

5. All DCCC activities shall involve the participation of the school personnel and youth leaders, partner stakeholders on climate change adaptation and mitigation supporting the education sector, and/or private individual/s with exemplary contribution to climate action in education.

6. With the upcoming opening of classes, activities requiring the participation of the school personnel and learners shall follow the policy on allowable curricular, co-curricular, and non-curricular events/programs. Refer to DepEd Order No. 66, s. 2017 and other similar issuances for the specifics.

7. Within 7 days after the activity/s, all SDOs shall submit a 5-minute video clip to the Regional DRRM Coordinator thru email address: megnon.beldad@deped.gov.ph. The video clips shall be included to the regional-level caravan scheduled on-air on **October 17, 2023**, via FB Livestreaming.

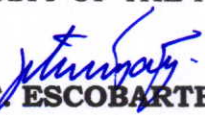
8. For the regional level caravan activities, this office shall issue a separate memorandum on the details of the activities particularly on the participation of the school personnel, learners, and/or partners.
