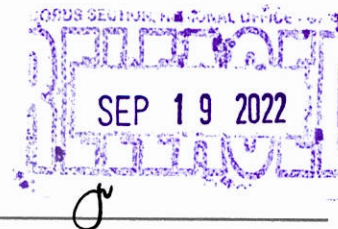

PARTICIPATION TO THE 1ST NATIONAL PEACE EDUCATION SUMMIT

1. 2. The inputs requested are related to recent innovations, trends, and concerns, challenges encountered, and solutions adopted in the fields of Peace Education, as well as comments/suggestions for the revision of the EO 570, s. 2006, "Institutionalizing Peace Education in Basic Education and Teacher Education." First of all, we would like to extend our utmost appreciation for your willingness to answer the call to intensify our collective peace education initiatives.

We would like to inform that the initially scheduled **1st National Peace Education Summit** on 21-24 September 2022 in Davao City shall be moved to **25-28 September 2022**. This emanated from the confirmed Congress budget hearing requiring full attention of the invited agencies, along with the challenges in securing the hotel accommodations for the expected participants from DepEd Regional Offices and Higher Education Institutions, and the need to strictly follow the provisions stipulated in RA 9184 or the Government Procurement Reform Act vis-à-vis the project team's options and the requirements and technicalities of the such event.

In lieu of these changes, we wish to inform you that our arrangements will still be the same.

2. If ever the participants have already registered, that is fine, provided that they are still available on September 25-28, 2022. Their registrations have already been noted.
3. The number of slots for the physical attendees shall be the same as the one reflected in the previous letter addressed to the respective DepEd Regional Directors.
4. OPAPRU will still be shouldering the participants' meals and hotel accommodation costs all throughout the duration of the summit.

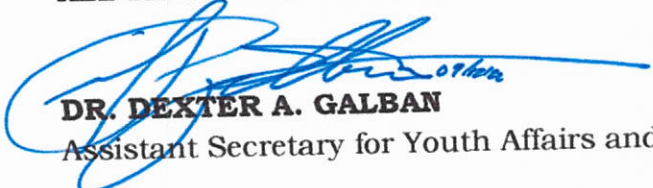

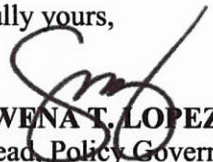
In view of the foregoing, we are pleased to invite your Regional Office to actively participate in this timely endeavor. We allotted **FIVE SLOTS** for your Region.

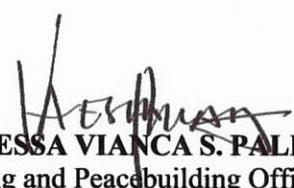
