The Bureau of Learning Delivery (BLD) shall conduct a training-workshop to upskill school leaders and expand their capabilities in managing the last mile Multigrade schools. This training supports the Basic Education Development Plan 2030 (BEDP 2030) in addressing the immediate impact of the pandemic on learning, participation, and education delivery in the multigrade context. Specifically, it aims to equip participants with the knowledge and skills essential to multigrade instruction particularly on the utilization of various multigrade teaching and learning resources, implementation of blended learning modalities, teaching reading in the early grades, adoption of multigrade instructional strategies and techniques, and school monitoring and evaluation.
