PARTICIPATION OF LEARNERS IN UNICEF'S U-REPORT POLL

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum DM-OUOPS-2025-11 dated July 28, 2025, the Department of Education, in partnership with the National Committee on Child and Youth Participation (NCCYP)—composed of UNICEF Philippines, BLSS-YFD, NYC, and CWC—seeks the active involvement of learners in the UNICEF U-Report Poll. This initiative will provide critical data to support the development of a National Framework on Children and Youth Participation.
2. The U-Report Poll is accessible via Facebook Messenger by searching for “U-Report Philippines” and sending the word “VOICE.” Respondents will answer six multiple-choice questions in English or Filipino regarding youth engagement and participation.
3. Target Respondents:
 - Learners and parents born between 1995–2012 (ages 13–30).
 - Participation is voluntary and adheres to the Data Privacy Act of 2012 (RA 10173).
4. Instructions to SDOs:
 - Each SDO shall identify one secondary school to represent the Division and select one section from the secondary school to answer the said survey poll.
 - To achieve the regional target, each Division must secure 40 responses before September 5, 2025.
 - The identified school, under the supervision of Youth Formation Division (YFD), shall maximize the use of the school laboratory to facilitate participation in the survey poll.

This is in relation to the ongoing initiative of the National Committee on Child and Youth Participation (NCCYP), specifically of the sub-working group composed of UNICEF Philippines, Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Learner Support Services – Youth Formation Division (BLSS-YFD); National Youth Commission (NYC); and Council for the Welfare of Children (CWC), to develop a National Framework on Children and Youth Participation.

Recognizing the lack of comprehensive data on the state of child and youth participation in the country, UNICEF Philippines launches **U-Report Poll**, a survey that aims to gather insights to shape the development of the Framework and subsequent policies, programs, and activities for children and youth.

As such, BLSS-YFD respectfully calls upon learners born between 1995–2012—or those age 13–30 years old this year—to respond to the said survey. The Poll contains six (6) multiple-choice questions that will examine children and youth experiences and perspectives on participation and engagement, all available in both English and Filipino. To access the Poll, respondents shall log into their Facebook Messenger accounts, search for U-Report Philippines, and send “VOICE” to begin answering the survey.

For additional reference of learner-respondents, their guardians, and concerned personnel on how to access the survey, a publication material from UNICEF is attached with this Memo.

To achieve the target number of respondents, Regional Youth Formation Coordinators (RYFCs) and Division Youth Formation Coordinators (DYFC) shall ensure that all Schools Divisions will be represented and accumulate a total of **450 responses from each region on or before September 5, 2025**. Regions can exceed the target should they wish to.

Each learner-respondent and their parent/guardian must accomplish the Learner and Parental Consent Form. 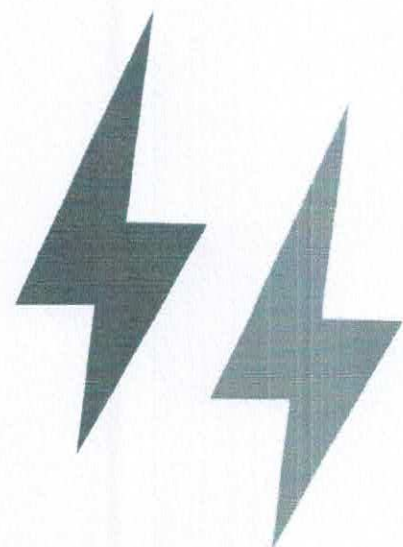
