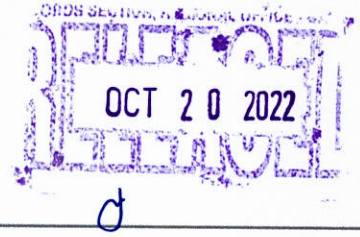

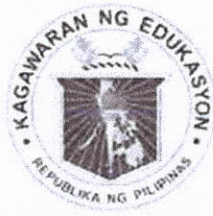

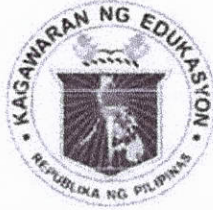
The focal person shall have the following duties:

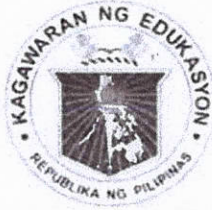

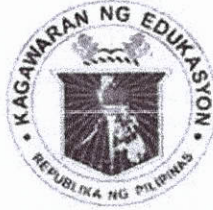
