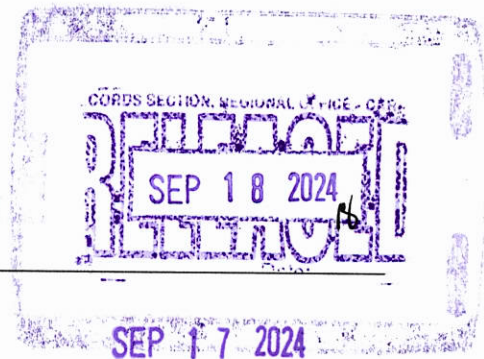

ALLOCATION OF CLASSROOM PER SCHOOL FOR LIBRARY FACILITY

1. In reference to the unnumbered DepEd Memorandum dated August 30, 2024, titled: Allocation of Classroom per School for Library Facility, the field is hereby enjoined to ensure that every school allots at least one (1) classroom as a library. This can be done by converting an existing excess classroom or allocating a new classroom in the case of new construction projects.
2. In addition, establishing provision of spaces intended for library services with a seating capacity of at least 10% of the schools' student population ensures compliance with the school library standards contained in DepEd Order No. 56, s. 2011.

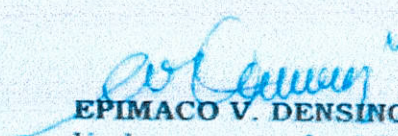


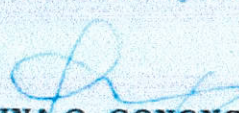

To enhance both physical and digital learning resources in schools and align with the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (UN-SDG) for quality education, Regional Directors are instructed to ensure that every school allots at least one (1) classroom as a library. In addition, establishing provision of spaces intended for library services with a seating capacity of at least 10% of the schools' student population ensures compliance with the school library standards contained in DepEd Order No. 56, s. 2011.
