In line with the Department of Education's (DepEd) MATATAG Basic Education Agenda, particularly to Give support to teachers to teach better, the Bureau of Learning Delivery - Student Inclusion Division (BLD-SID) aims to produce a comprehensive set of lesson exemplars on Special Program in Journalism (SPJ) designed to facilitate effective, engaging, and meaningful journalism instruction while also promoting the development of essential 21st-century skills. To achieve this goal, the BLD-SID will conduct the following activities:

Specifically, these activities aim to:

- A. Develop, validate, and finalize lesson exemplars in SPJ that promote 21st-century skills integration;

- B. Strengthen the capacity of SPJ implementers in empowering learners to become proficient, ethical, and socially responsible journalists and media professionals in the digital age; and
- C. Express strong commitment and advocacy toward the effective and efficient learning delivery of SPJ.

Participants in these activities are select **SPJ implementers and Regional and Division Supervisors** (See Annex A). The criteria for the selection of participants are specified in Annex B.

However, to ensure the development of substantial number of lesson exemplars, the Regional Supervisors in charge of SPJ are requested to identify additional online participants for each phase of the writeshop who will also be oriented via Zoom and work remotely on the expected outputs. To join the activities, Zoom meeting link and passcode will be sent through their respective email addresses.

Face-to-face participants are advised to take the most economical means of transportation. They are expected to arrive at the venue a day before the activity. The first meal to be served is **dinner on Day 0** while the last meal is **lunch on Day 3**. They are also reminded to bring their laptop. See Annex C for the indicative program of activities.
