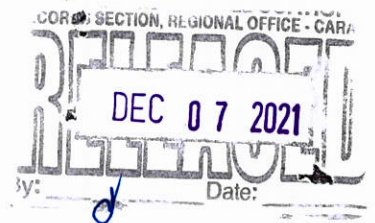

DATE : November 29, 2021

The Office of the Assistant Secretary for Alternative Learning System (ALS) through the Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE) will conduct the National Consultative Conference for Regional ALS Focal Persons on December 7-10, 2021 (inclusive of travel time) in Region V, Legaspi City (*exact venue to be announced*).

The objectives of the activity are to: a) discuss the ALS Act and its Implementing Rules and Regulations, the New Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE) and ALS Operations Manual; b) plan the ALS Law and IRR roadshow per region; c) assess the efficiency and effectiveness of ALS Programs and Projects' implementation for CY 2021; and d) provide directions for the remaining activities - for FY 2021 & plan of activities for BAE FY 2022 and onwards.

In view of this, may we invite the Regional ALS Focal Persons to participate in the abovementioned activity. They are requested to prepare and submit a 5 -10-minute video presentation of their regional accomplishments highlighting the 2021 Program Support Fund (PSF) utilization. Further, they are requested to confirm their attendance to either physically or virtually attend, on or before December 3, 2021.

Board and lodging, and other expenses relative to the conduct of the activity shall be charged against the 2021 FLO funds. **The BAE shall download funds for the travelling expenses of participants** subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations. **They are also allowed to use their remaining 2021 Program Support Funds for the said purpose.**

Further, may we also request **Mr. Ricardo Tejeresas** to identify two (2) ALS implementors to serve as documenters. They are expected to submit the minutes of the meeting on December 14, 2021, through email at clarisa.toribio@deped.gov.ph
