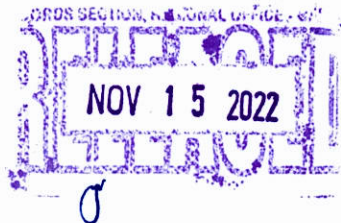

TURNOVER OF THE PANTAWID FAMILYANG PILIPINO PROGRAM (4Ps)
MONITORING AND GENERATION OF REPORTS TO THE DEPARTMENT
OF SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT (DSWD)

1. In reference to the communication letter of DepEd-Office of the Undersecretary and Chief of Staff, Epimaco V. Densing III, to the Secretary of DSWD, the Hon. Erwin T. Tulfo, this office hereby informs all Schools Division offices and its schools that **DepEd shall no longer allow its teachers to facilitate the monitoring and generation of reports for the 4Ps in their respective schools**, pursuant to DepEd's objective of lessening the non-teaching workload of the teachers.
2. All Schools Division Superintendents are instructed to coordinate with their respective counterparts at the DSWD and local government units to facilitate the immediate transition and turnover of the aforementioned tasks to the DSWD.
3. Per OASGFO No. 2022-067 issued from the Office of the Assistant Secretary for Governance and Field Operations of DepEd-CO, this office also directs all SDOs to submit reports on the actions taken regarding this directive not later than November 17, 2022.

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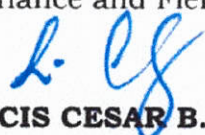

In line with the Department's continued effort to lessen the teachers' non-teaching workload by removing administrative tasks from their stead, we were able to identify that our teachers are being tasked to monitor and generate reports for the Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps) in their respective schools.

In this regard, we would like to inform you that we shall no longer allow our teachers to facilitate the monitoring of 4Ps in their respective institutions of learning. This is in line with the Department of Education's thrust that teachers shall focus on teaching.

Further, please be guided that Republic Act No. 11310 otherwise known as "An Act Institutionalizing the Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program" and its Implementing Rules and Regulations does not mandate our department's personnel from monitoring and accomplishing reports relative to the program.

As such, we intend to advise at the soonest possible time our teachers to turn over these tasks to your personnel.
