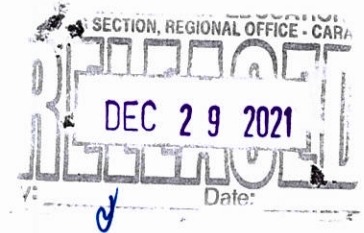

**VOLUNTEERS FOR THE CONDUCT OF HEALTH AND NUTRITION
SERVICES TO SDOs AFFECTED BY TYPHOON ODETTE**

1. Typhoon Odette has brought devastation to some areas in Caraga, where thousands of families have been rendered homeless, without food and water, and the threat of outbreak of diseases. This office recognizes the need to deploy a team to provide medical services, emergency school feeding and Mental Health and Psychosocial Support Services (MHPSS) to affected learners and DepEd personnel.
2. In line with this, we are asking for volunteers (Medical Doctors, Dentists, Nurses, Psychologists, Registered Guidance Counsellors, and other allied health professionals) to compose the team. The list of volunteers shall be reviewed and approved by the SGOD Chief and Schools Division Superintendent. The approved list shall be submitted through email at caragaessd.hnu@deped.gov.ph on or before January 3, 2022.
3. All volunteers are requested to join the virtual coordination/consultative meeting on January 4, 2022, at 2:00 PM. The meeting link shall be forwarded to the OKD Facebook chat group a day before.
4. Travelling expenses of volunteers incurred during the deployment shall be charged to the MOOE funds of the sending office subject to the usual accounting rules and regulations.
