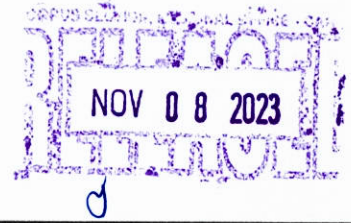

 - a. Personal Data Sheet (CSC Form 212, rev. 2017)
 - b. Endorsement from Immediate Supervisor
 - c. Endorsement from the Schools Division Office thru the Office of the Schools Division Superintendent
 - d. Proof of Outstanding Accomplishment (Certificates, photo of plaque/medal/trophy, manuscript, etc.) duly certified true and correct by the applicant's immediate supervisor
 - e. Rated IPCRF for the past two (2) years
 - f. Updated Service Record
 - g. Certificate of No Pending Administrative/Legal Charges
 - h. Scholarship Clearance (downloadable at bit.ly/46X2TrU)
4. The Learning and Development Nomination Form and Official Endorsement by the Regional Director will be released to the selected nominee after the thorough evaluation of submitted documents.
5. Online submission of complete documents by the nominee using the official DepEd email account shall be on or before **November 10, 2023** at bit.ly/LKYApplications.

6. The LKYSPP Scholarships Assessment Committee will issue the final list of successful applicants to the master's degree programmes based on the nominations forwarded by the DepEd Scholarship Secretariat.
