REGIONAL IMPLEMENTATION OF WAVE 2 KHAN ACADEMY ACTIVITIES
FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2025-2026

1. Pursuant to OM-OASOPS No. 2025-140A dated October 9, 2025, and in line with the continuing partnership between the Department of Education (DepEd) and Khan Academy, this Office implements Wave 2 of the Khan Academy program in public schools across Caraga Region for School Year 2025-2026.
2. The implementation of Wave 2 Khan Academy activities aims to:
 - a. expand the reach of Khan Academy as a supplementary learning resource in Mathematics, Science, and Alternative Learning System (ALS);
 - b. strengthen the technological readiness of additional schools in the region;
 - c. equip teachers with competencies in utilizing Khan Academy as an instructional tool; and
 - d. provide personalized learning opportunities for students through adaptive technology-based instruction.
3. Attached is a copy of OM-OASOPS No. 2025-140A which outlines the complete schedule of activities, participation requirements, and implementation guidelines for Wave 2. The following timelines shall be observed for the successful implementation of the program:

- ii. **Session 2: Getting Started with Khan Academy (Face-to-Face Training)**
 - o Date: **February 7-8, 2026**
 - o Participants: Teacher-implementers of Math, Science, and ALS; Regional, SDO, and School Khan Academy Focal Persons
 - o Note: SDOs are requested to provide training venue and meals for participants

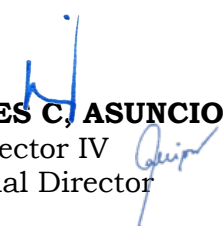

The target participants for the various implementation activities include: Public School District Supervisors (PSDSs) handling interested schools; Khan Academy Focal Persons at the school, division, and regional levels; School Principals and Assistant Principals; Mathematics, Science, and ALS Department Heads or subject focal persons; School ICT Coordinators and Division IT Officers; and all qualified teacher-implementers in Mathematics, Science, and ALS who will undergo the training and onboarding sessions as scheduled.

All Schools Division Superintendents are directed to immediately disseminate this Memorandum to all public elementary and secondary schools in their respective divisions and to provide the necessary support for the successful implementation of Wave 2 Khan Academy activities, including: (1) ensuring timely submission of school nominations; (2) facilitating school verification visits and ensuring that SDO personnel (EPS, PSDS, or Division IT Officer) accompany the verification team; (3) securing training venues and meals for the February face-to-face training sessions; (4) ensuring maximum participation of concerned personnel; and (5) granting Compensatory Time-Off or Service Credits to teachers and personnel attending weekend training sessions, subject to all relevant DepEd rules and regulations.

On School Verification

Khan Academy personnel will visit each identified school to validate technological readiness (internet connectivity, availability of student devices, and teacher/administrator readiness). SDO personnel (EPS, PSDS, or Division IT Officer) are requested to accompany the verification team to ensure swift and efficient validation. **Schools are not required to prepare programs, lay, or food;** the visits will last approximately for 20–30 minutes only. It is also requested that school devices be powered on during the scheduled visit to facilitate testing of internet connectivity.

All concerned Regions, SDOs, and schools are enjoined to ensure the timely submission of school nominations and to extend full support to the scheduled verification and training activities. This will ensure the smooth inclusion of additional schools and the successful rollout of Wave 2.

As part of the implementation support, the concerned Regions and SDOs are requested to provide the necessary training venue and meals for participants during the scheduled face-to-face training activities.

To ensure maximum participation, it is also requested that Compensatory Time-Off or Service Credits be granted to teachers and personnel who will attend training sessions that fall on weekends, subject to all relevant rules and regulations of the Department of Education.
