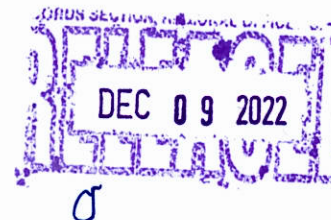

The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Learning Delivery-Teaching and Learning Division (BLD-TLD), shall conduct the **Writeshop on the Finalization of the Philippine Informal Reading Inventory (Phil-IRI) for Junior High School (JHS)** from December 12 to 16, 2022 at Tanza Oasis Hotel, Tanza, Cavite.

Specifically, this activity aims for the participants to revise and finalize the Phil-IRI for Junior High School reading materials based on the results of the expert validation and pilot testing.
