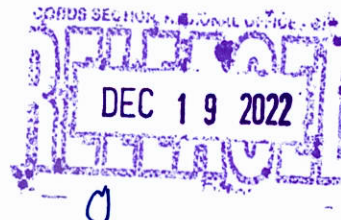

CONDUCT OF 19th NATIONAL CONSULTATIVE CONFERENCE FOR
REGIONAL ALS FOCAL PERSONS AND SELECT DEPED OFFICIALS

1. Pursuant to Memorandum OM-OAGA-2022-179, dated December 9, 2022, from the Office of the Assistant Secretary for Alternative Learning System (ALS) through the Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE), the 19th National Consultative Conference shall be conducted on January 30 to February 3, 2023 (inclusive of travel time) in Region VI. The venue will be announced in an advisory issuance.
2. Regional and division ALS focal persons are required to attend the conference. No replacement is allowed.
3. Travel expenses of participants shall be charged against Alternative Learning System (ALS) Current Funds for Fiscal Year (FY) 2022, which shall be downloaded by the Regional Office to their respective Division Offices subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. If the downloaded fund is insufficient to cover the actual expenses, the excess amount shall be charged against the local funds or Division ALS Program Support Funds (PSF) for Fiscal Year 2022.
4. All Division Focal Persons and EPSAs are required to attend the meeting on December 21, 2022, at 8:00 AM for a collaborative preparation of the region's presentation through the Google Meet link: <https://meet.google.com/nqq-hico-don>

DATE : **December 9, 2022**

The Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE) is scheduled to conduct the **19th National Consultative Conference for Regional ALS Focal Persons and Select DepEd Officials on January 30 to February 3, 2023** (inclusive of travel time) in Region VI (the venue shall be communicated in a separate issuance).

The said activity aims to:

1. present the 2022 Accomplishment Reports of BAE and the regions in the implementation of Alternative Learning System (ALS);
2. share the best practices of the regions on the following:
 - a. Innovation in ALS
 - b. ALS SHS Pilot Implementation
 - c. ALS in SBM
 - d. ALS Program Delivery
3. prepare a regional strategic plan aligned with the strategic goals of BAE; and
4. discuss issues and concerns in the implementation of ALS programs.

In view of this, all **Regional ALS Focal Persons** and **Division ALS Focal Persons** are expected to participate in the abovementioned activity. Replacement of participants is not allowed. Please see **Attachment 1** for the guidelines on the expected presentations of each region.

Further, **Mr. Nestor Paul Pingil**, Regional ALS Focal Person of Region VI, is requested to assign at least three (3) documenters during the conference. They are expected to submit the minutes of the meeting to BAE on or before February 17, 2023.

Transportation, board and lodging, and other expenses relative to the conduct of the activity shall be charged against the Fiscal Year (FY) 2022 ALS Current Funds. Travel expenses of participants shall be reimbursed through the fund to be downloaded to their respective regions subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Should the downloaded fund intended for this purpose is insufficient to cover the actual, additional and other allowable expenses, the excess amount shall be charged against the local funds or the ALS Program Support Funds (PSF) for FY 2022.

All participants are required to comply with all the guidelines for COVID-19 Alert Level System set by the national and local Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging and Infectious Diseases (IATF), as well as the most recent DepEd rules and/or policies.

First meal to be served is dinner on January 30, 2023, and the last meal is lunch on February 3, 2023. Please see **Attachment 2** (*Indicative Program of Activities*) for your reference.

Guidelines for Regional Presentation

I. 2022 Accomplishment of the Regions

A. Gallery Walk

1. Each region is expected to prepare its 2022 Accomplishment Report which will be presented during the Gallery Walk.
2. The 2022 Accomplishment Report shall include, but not limited to, programs, projects, and activities on the implementation of Alternative Learning System.
3. The 2022 Accomplishment Report should be placed in a tarpaulin not bigger than 6ft. x 3ft. and shall not exceed to two (2) pieces.
4. The Regional ALS Focal Person shall submit to BAE the tarpaulin during the registration on January 30, 2023.

B. Newsletter/Flyer/Leaflet

1. Each region shall also prepare its 2022 Accomplishment Report in the form of newsletter, flyer, or leaflet.
2. The 2022 Accomplishment Report shall include, but not limited to, programs, projects and activities on the implementation of Alternative Learning System.
3. The region shall reproduce the newsletter/flyer/leaflet to 300 copies enough for the number of participants of the conference. The regional focal must submit a digital format to BAE.
4. The newsletter/flyer/leaflet will be distributed to the participants during the Gallery Walk.

II. Sharing of Best Practices (Parallel Sessions)

1. Each region will be given a chance to share its best practices in all of the topics and requirements given below.

Topic	Description/Requirement	Time allotment
Innovation in ALS	one (1) innovative or unique program/project in the implementation of ALS initiated by the region or schools division	20mins
ALS SHS Implementation	One (1) school that successfully implements ALS Senior High School	20mins
ALS in SBM	One (1) school that received funding for ALS SBM and successfully continues its implementation	20mins

2. The presentation can be a video or a powerpoint presentation which shall be presented during the parallel sessions by either the Regional ALS Focal Person or the Division ALS Focal Person.
3. The presentation shall not exceed the provided time allotment.

III. Sharing of Identified Distinct ALS Program Learning Delivery (Plenary Session)

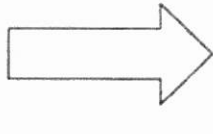
1. Identified distinct ALS Program Learning Delivery will be presented during a plenary session.
