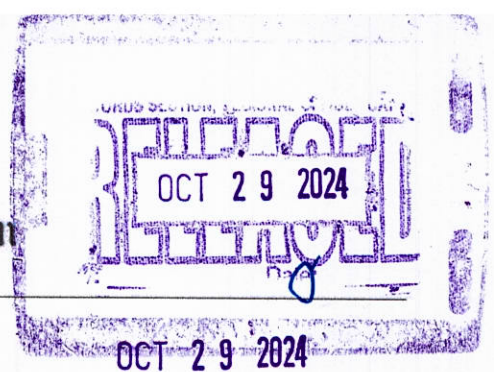

SUBMISSION OF QUARTER 1 EXAMINATION RESULTS IN SCIENCE
THROUGH THE INTERNET- AND CLOUD-BASED LEARNING
ASSESSMENT SUBMISSION SYSTEM (iCLASS)
SCHOOL YEAR 2024-2025

1. The field is hereby informed of the activation of the Internet- and Cloud-based Learning Assessment Submission System (iCLASS) v.3.1 starting October 28 to November 8, 2024.

2. The iCLASS is used to determine the number of students in each proficiency level, mean percentage scores, least-learned competencies, teachers' challenges on teaching Science, and teachers' learning and development needs. These results will inform education leaders on what trainings and interventions shall be made at the different governance levels.

3. The iCLASS is the monitoring and evaluation (M&E) tool for the Sukdanan Standardized Assessments. The iCLASS links are accessible through the following links:
