REGIONAL TRAINING OF TEACHERS ON THE REVISED ALTERNATIVE
LEARNING SYSTEM (ALS) CURRICULUM

1. Pursuant to its goal to provide quality, inclusive, relevant and liberating learning opportunities, DepEd ALS Opportunity 2.0 Program, the Department of Education Caraga Region, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) with the Human Resource Development Division (HRDD) will conduct the Regional Training of Teachers on the Revised Alternative Learning System (ALS) Curriculum. This training will be conducted in two batches and hosted by Surigao del Sur Division. The venue will be specified in an upcoming document.

2. The activity schedule is as follows:
- Speakers Pre-work conference January 6, 2026
 - Batch 1: January 7-10, 2026
 - Batch 2: January 12-15, 2026

Additional details regarding the specific venue will be provided in a separate memorandum.

3. The primary objectives of this training are as follows:
- To familiarize ALS teachers with the key updates and new features of the Revised ALS Curriculum.
 - To deepen understanding of the learning strands and competency framework to enhance instruction and learner assessment.
 - To develop teachers' capacities in planning and delivering differentiated learning sessions tailored to ALS learners' diverse needs.
 - To strengthen skills in conducting assessment and utilizing the ALS A&E system for monitoring and supporting learner progress.

4. Expected participants for this activity include Division ALS Focal Persons, EPSAs, ALS Teachers, and members of the Program Management Team from the 12 Schools Division Offices.

5. To ensure effective coordination and preparation for the event, Division ALS Focal Persons are requested to submit the list of participants using the provided template available at the link. Please comply on or before December 20, 2025.
