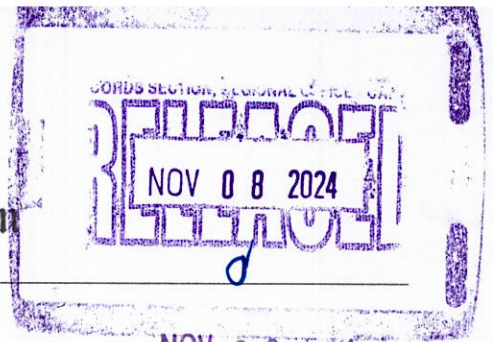

As part of the Department of Education's (DepEd) commitment to promote and advance inclusive education through the Special Needs Education (SNED), the Bureau of Learning Delivery-Students Inclusion Division (BLD-SID) shall conduct the **Orientation of Core Trainers for the Training of Receiving Kindergarten Teachers on Special Needs Education (SNED) Content and Pedagogy** on **October 28-30, 2024** at a venue within the National Capital region, to be announced on a separate advisory.

The following are the objectives of the activity:

1. SNED Core Trainers shall be able to improve their Knowledge, Skills, and Attitude (KSA) in managing and implementing related to SNED Content and Pedagogy; and
2. Trainers shall focus on subject matter expertise, instructional techniques, communication, adaptability, group dynamics, technology use, evaluation, confidence, adult learning principles, and continuous professional development, addressing diverse learning styles.

For information, the National Educators' Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) representatives are involved in this activity and shall provide technical assistance for developing the session guides and ensuring the quality of the orientation.

Board and lodging, and travel expenses of the participants shall be charged to **2024 Special Needs Education (SNED Funds)**. In case the downloaded funds will not be enough, additional funds shall be sourced out through the available local funds, subject to usual auditing and accounting rules and regulations. On the other hand, the traveling expenses of BARMM participants are charged against their local funds.

The first meal of the participants is breakfast on October 28, 2024, and the last meal to be served shall be lunch on October 30, 2024.
