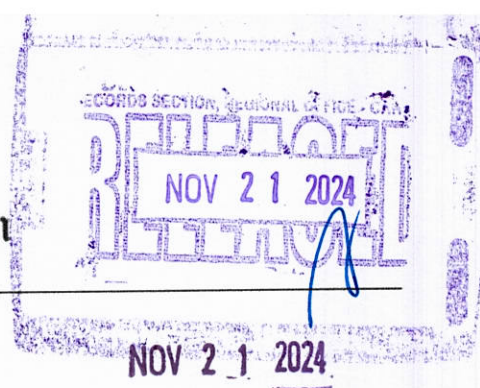

**PARTICIPATION IN THE 32ND REGIONAL CHILDREN'S
MONTH CELEBRATION - CULMINATING PROGRAM**

1. In line with Republic Act No. 10661, which declares November of every year as National Children's Month, commemorating the adoption of the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC), this office commits to celebrating and promoting children's rights.
2. Relatedly, the Department of Education (DepEd), through the Learner Rights and Protection Office (LRPO), joins the Council for the Welfare of the Children (CWC), the National Youth Commission (NYC), and the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), local government units, and private organizations including the civil society, private enterprises, and government and civil organizations in celebrating the 32nd National Children's Month (NCM) with the theme *Break the Prevalence, End the Violence: Protecting Children, Creating a Safe Philippines!*.
3. In this regard, all Schools Division Offices (SDOs) are requested to participate in the Regional Children's Month Celebration - Culminating program scheduled for November 28, 2024. The specific venue is to be announced in a subsequent communication.
4. Eight SSLG Officers per division are invited to participate in the program, while the Division Learner Rights and Protection Coordinators are requested to join as chaperones.
5. For participants who are minors, parental or guardian consent is mandatory. Additionally, arrangements must be made to ensure that these participants are accompanied by their designated chaperones throughout the event.
6. Confirmed participants including the Division LRP Coordinator, and SSLG Officers, or those in similar roles must register via this link: <https://bit.ly/32ndRegionalChildrensMonthCelebration-CulminatingProgram> not later than November 21, 2024.
7. Learner participants are expected to complete any missed activities or requirements upon returning to classes.

8. Travel expenses for coordinators and learners will be charged against the Program Support Funds, MOOE, Local funds, the Local School Board - Special Education Fund (LSB-SEF) or other funding sources, subject to standard accounting and auditing rules and regulations, and DepEd internal policies.
9. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
