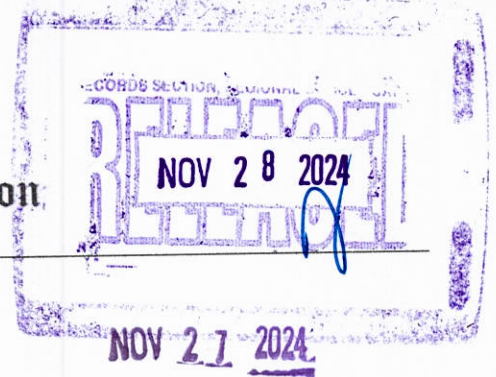

ONLINE TRAINING SESSION 3 ON EFFECTIVELY MONITORING STUDENT
PROGRESS WITH KHAN ACADEMY: NAVIGATING DASHBOARDS
AND REPORTS FOR SUCCESS

1. The Department of Education (DepEd), in collaboration with Khan Academy Philippines Inc., will conduct Training Session 3 titled **"Effectively Monitoring Student Progress with Khan Academy: Navigating Dashboards and Reports for Success"** on **Friday, November 29, 2024, from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.** via <https://www.facebook.com/groups/khanphyear2>.
2. This specialized training aims to enhance teachers' ability to track student progress through their Teacher's Dashboard. Participants will learn how to effectively navigate Khan Academy's dashboard, generate insightful reports to monitor student performance in real-time, and discover strategies for using data to improve teaching practices and help students achieve their academic goals.
3. The list of Khan Academy implementing schools in Caraga Region is attached for reference.
4. Only teachers who participated in Session 2, conducted in Tandag City (Cluster 1) and Cabadbaran City (Cluster 2) on November 23, 2024, are eligible to attend this training. This requirement ensures that participants have already implemented Khan Academy in their classrooms and populated their dashboards with student data, making the training more meaningful and practical. Teachers who were unable to attend the previous session are encouraged to join Learning Action Cell (LAC) sessions facilitated by colleagues who attended Session 2. These sessions will focus on implementing Khan Academy in their schools until December 2024. Completing these steps is necessary to qualify for the next Session 3 training, scheduled for January 2025, after demonstrating classroom implementation.
5. Principals, department heads, and supervisors are enjoined to attend.
