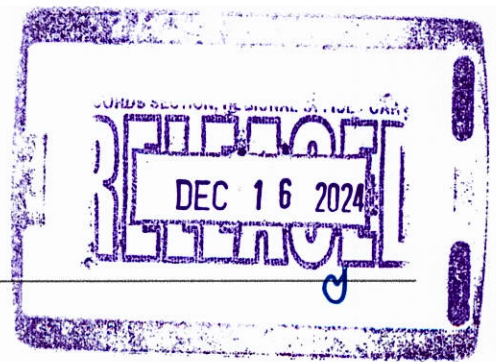

**CONDUCT OF VALIDATION IN ACTION: SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON EFFECTIVE
VALIDATION AND DATA ANALYSIS ON THE MONITORING AND EVALUATION
IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF MATATAG CURRICULUM**

1. To ensure the successful implementation of the MATATAG curriculum, there is a need to strengthen monitoring and evaluation (M&E) practices through effective validation techniques and accurate data analysis, a seminar-workshop in which participants will be able to have the necessary tools and skills to address challenges, foster collaboration, and formulate actionable recommendations for enhanced curriculum delivery.
